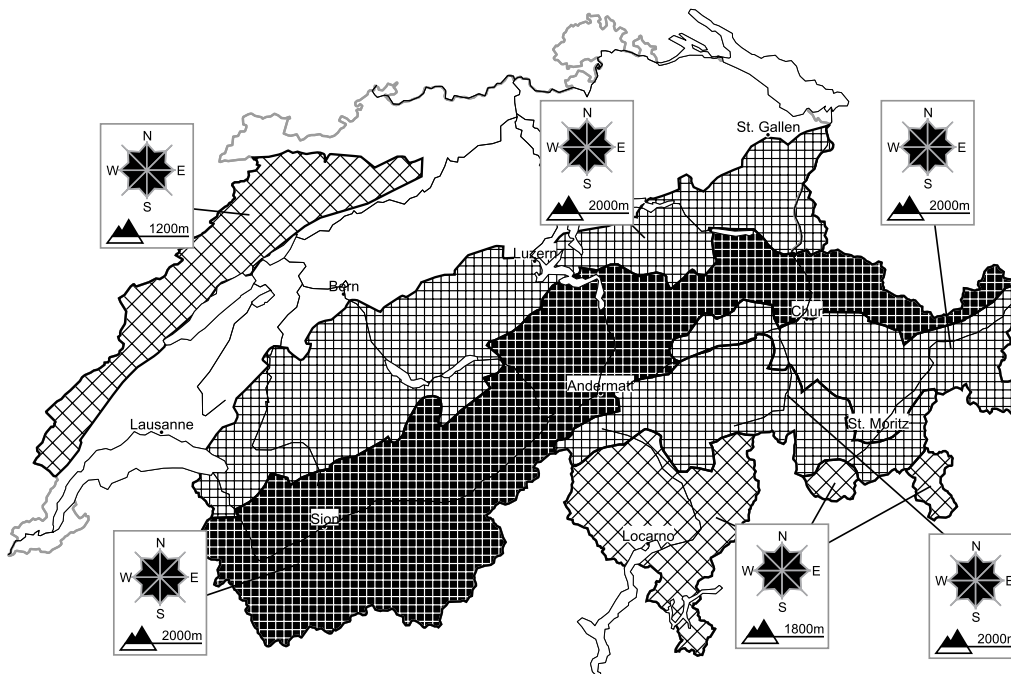


As a consequence of fresh snow and stormy weather a very high avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

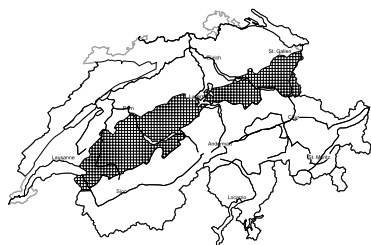

Danger description

The fresh snow and snow drift accumulations are prone to triggering. Avalanches can be released very easily. Small and medium-sized natural avalanches are to be expected. Individual large avalanches are possible. Exposed parts of transportation routes are endangered. Safety measures are to be reviewed. The conditions are unfavourable for snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes.

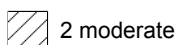
Wet and full-depth avalanches

As a consequence of the rain a large number of medium-sized and, in isolated cases, large full-depth and wet avalanches are to be expected. This applies in all aspects below approximately 2000 m.

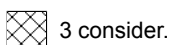
Danger levels



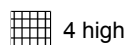

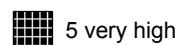
2 moderate
