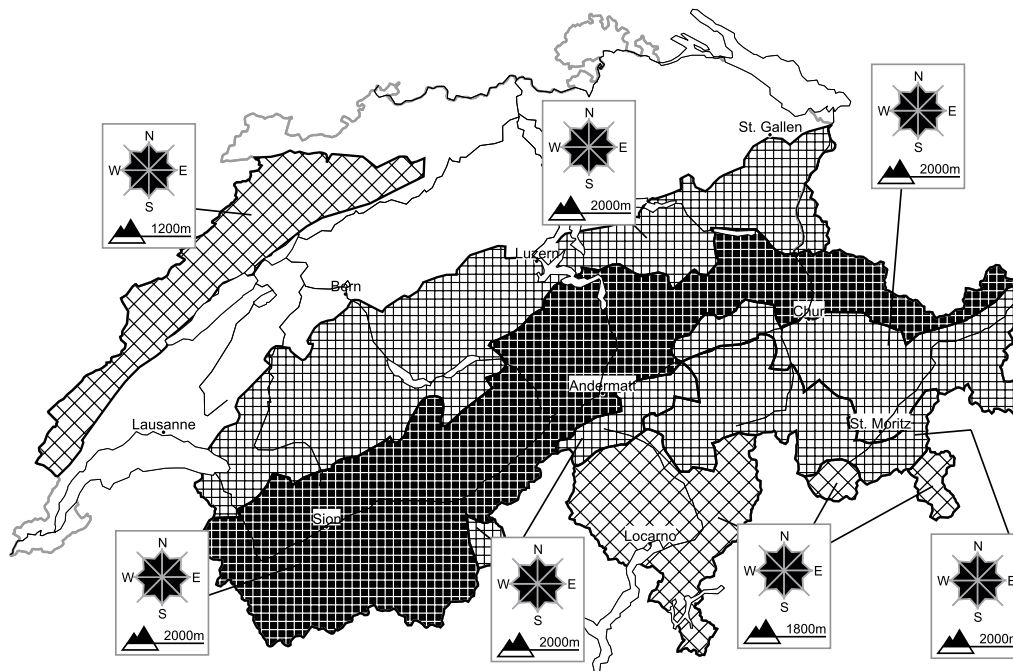


# As a consequence of fresh snow and warming a very high avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

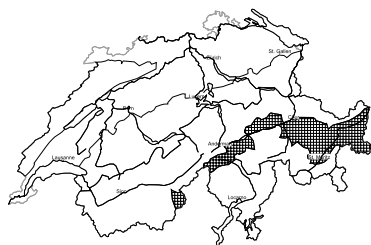

## Avalanche danger



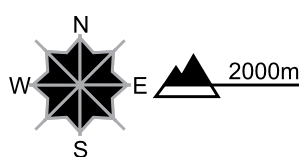
### region C

### Fresh snow and snow drifts, old snow

#### Danger description

The fresh snow and snow drift accumulations are prone to triggering. Avalanches can be released very easily. Medium-sized and, in isolated cases, large natural avalanches are to be expected. Exposed parts of transportation routes are endangered. Safety measures are to be reviewed. The conditions are unfavourable for snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes.

### Full-depth avalanches

More frequent full-depth avalanches are to be expected, including quite large ones. This applies in all aspects below approximately 2200 m. Caution is to be exercised in areas with glide cracks. Slides are to be expected on cut slopes.
