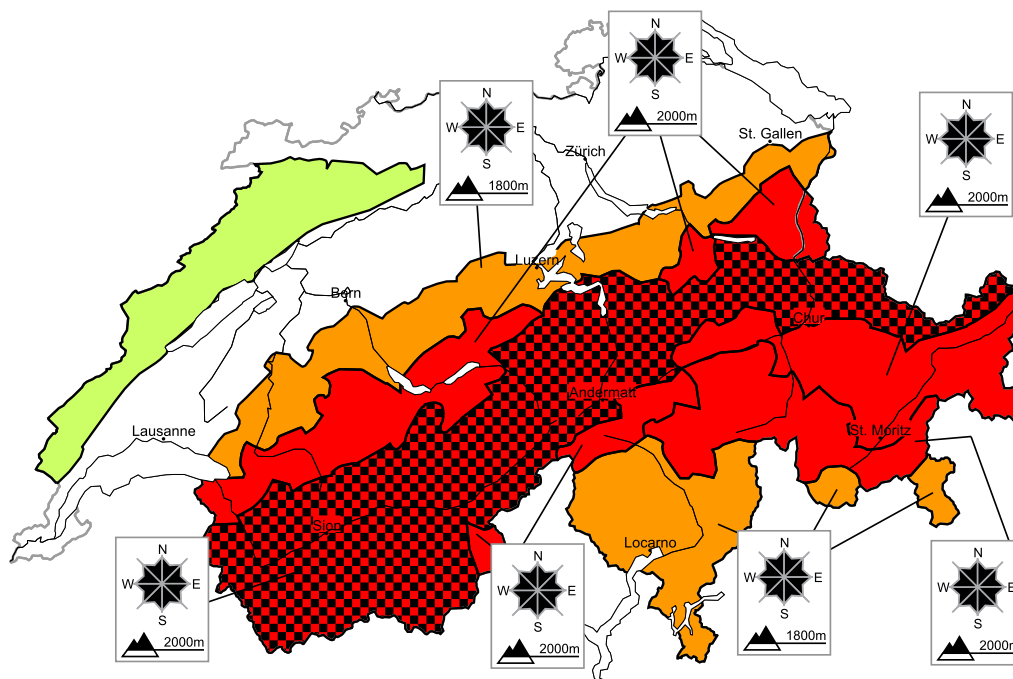


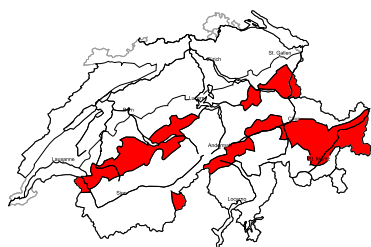

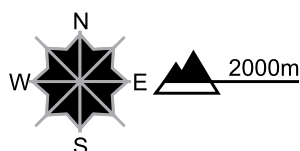


region B **Level 4, high**

Danger description

The fresh snow and snow drift accumulations are prone to triggering. Avalanches can be released easily. Medium-sized and, in isolated cases, large natural avalanches are to be expected. Exposed parts of transportation routes are endangered. Safety measures are to be maintained during the night.

With the end of the precipitation, the natural avalanche activity will appreciably decrease. Individual avalanches are however still possible. These can as before reach dangerously large size.

The conditions are unfavourable for snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes.

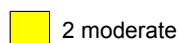
Wet and full-depth avalanches

As a consequence of the rain wet avalanches are to be expected. This applies in particular during the night. At any time full-depth avalanches are possible, including quite large ones. This applies in all aspects below approximately 2200 m.

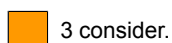
Danger levels



1 low



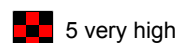
2 moderate
