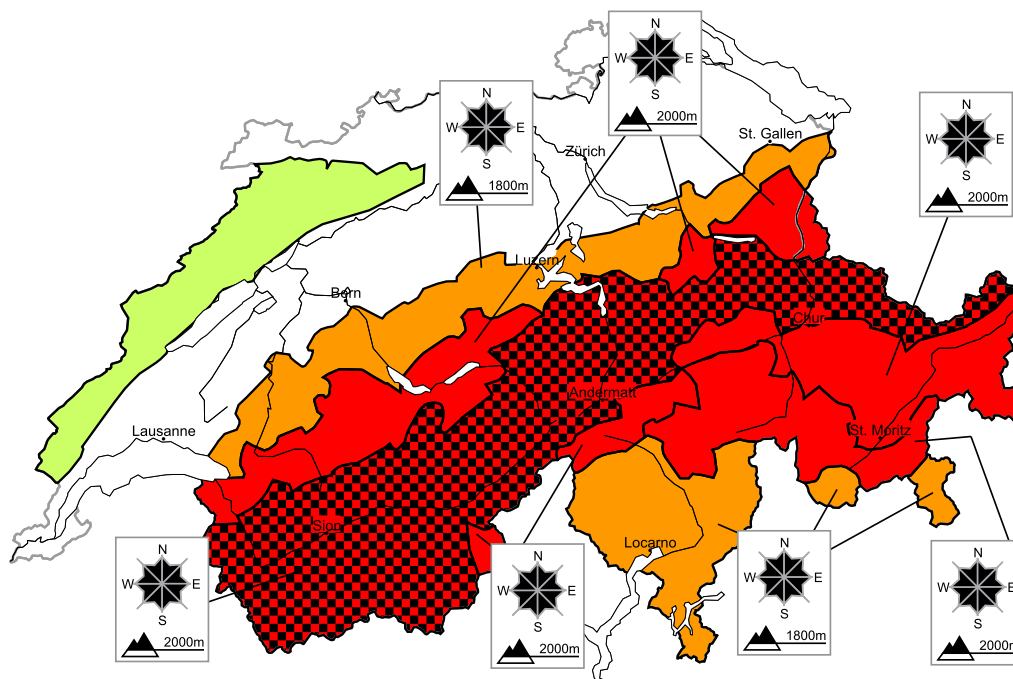


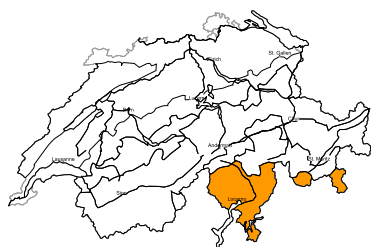

Avalanche danger

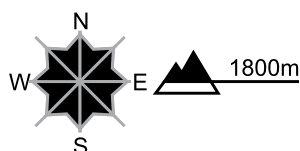


region D **Level 3, considerable**

Danger description

The fresh snow and snow drift accumulations of the last few days are in some cases prone to triggering. As a consequence of the northerly wind further snow drift accumulations will form. Avalanches can be released, even by a single winter sport participant. They can in isolated cases penetrate deep layers and reach dangerously large size. Snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and caution.

Full-depth avalanches

Individual full-depth avalanches are possible. This applies in all aspects below approximately 2200 m. Caution is to be exercised in areas with glide cracks.
