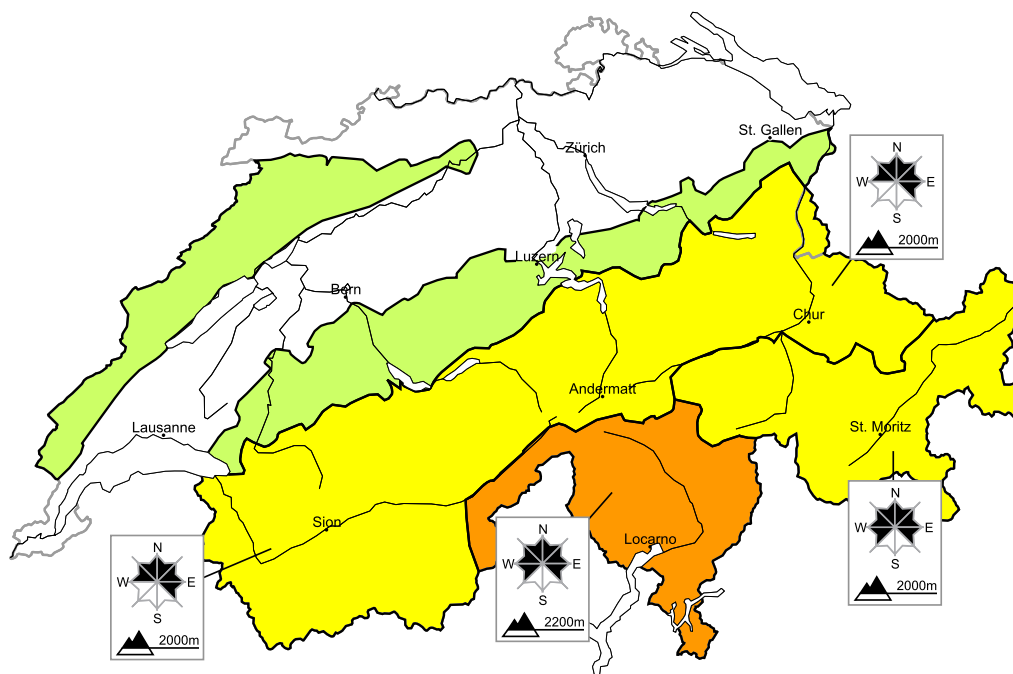


In the south a considerable avalanche danger will be encountered in some regions. Full-depth avalanches on steep grassy slopes

Avalanche danger



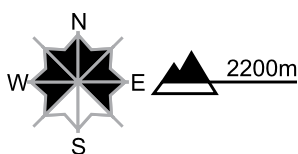
region A

Danger description

As a consequence of fresh snow and wind snow drift accumulations will form, in particular at high altitudes and in high Alpine regions. The fresh snow and snow drift accumulations can be released easily. Experience in the assessment of avalanche danger is required.

Full-depth avalanches

Below approximately 2200 m full-depth avalanches are possible. This applies in particular on steep east, south and west facing slopes. They can be released at any time of day or night. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided as far as possible.

1 low

2 moderate

3 consider.

4 high

5 very high
