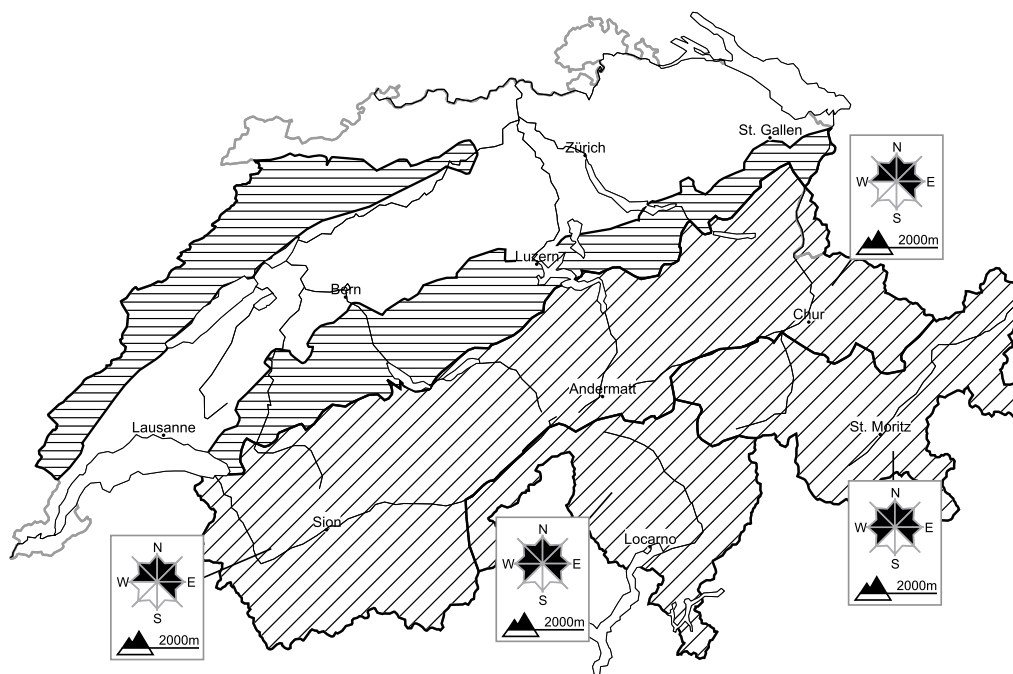


Moderate avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area. Full-depth avalanches on steep grassy slopes

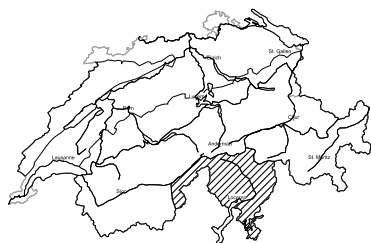

Avalanche danger



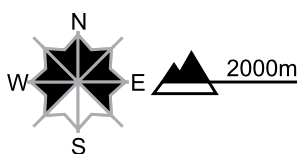
region A

Avalanche prone locations



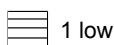
Danger description

Less fresh snow than expected: As a consequence of fresh snow and wind rather small snow drift accumulations have formed, in particular at high altitudes and in high Alpine regions. Here avalanche prone locations are more prevalent. The snow drift accumulations can be released easily. Careful route selection is required.

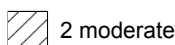
Full-depth avalanches

Below approximately 2200 m full-depth avalanches are possible. This applies in particular on steep east, south and west facing slopes. They can be released at any time of day or night. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided as far as possible.

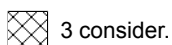
Danger levels



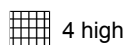

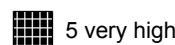
