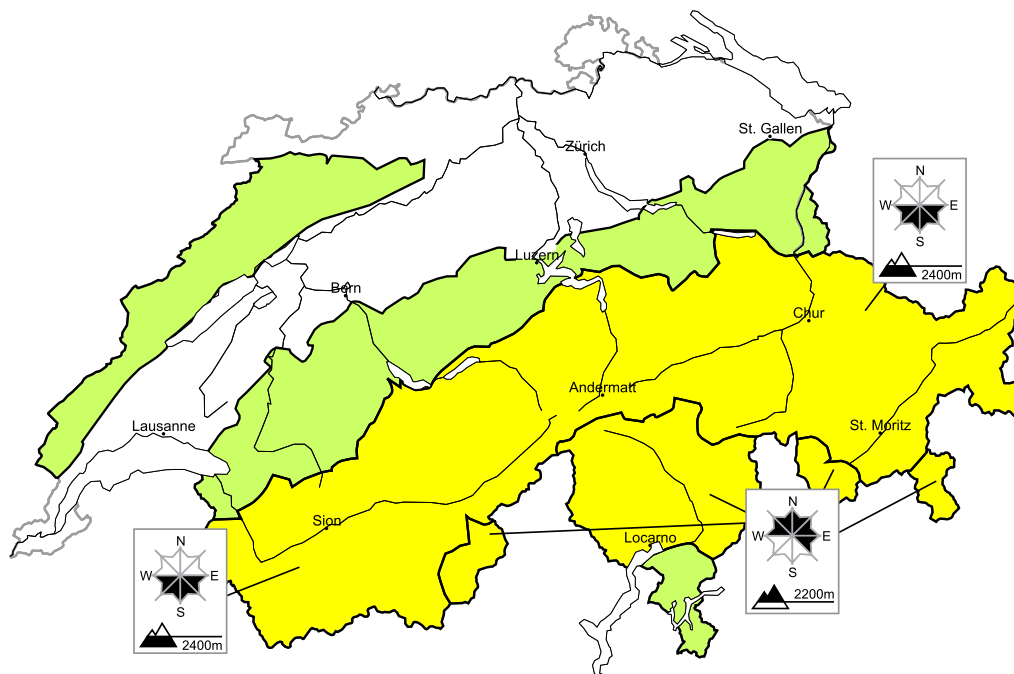

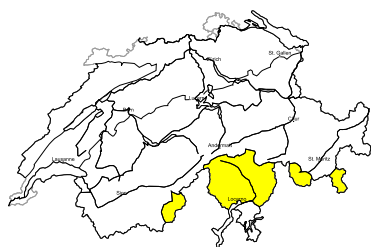

region B

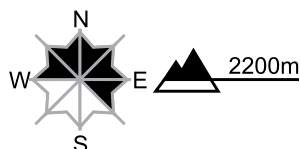
Level 2, moderate

Danger description



The mostly small snow drift accumulations represent the main danger. They can be released by a single winter sport participant in some cases. Careful route selection is recommended.

Full-depth avalanches

Below approximately 2200 m full-depth avalanches are possible. This applies in particular on steep east, south and west facing slopes. They can be released at any time of day or night. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided as far as possible.

Danger levels

1 low

2 moderate

3 consider.

4 high

5 very high
