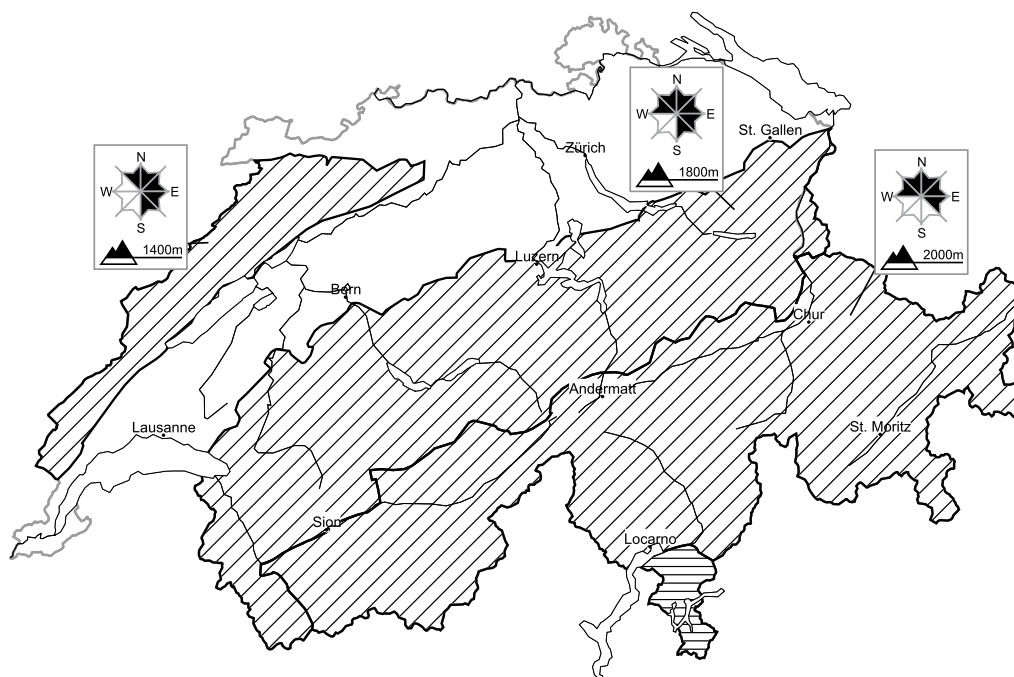


Fresh snow drifts require caution. Slight increase in avalanche danger as the day progresses

Avalanche danger



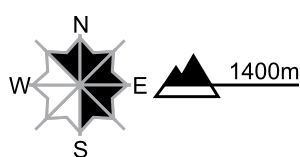

Avalanche prone locations



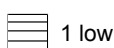
Danger description

As a consequence of fresh snow and wind small snow drift accumulations will form. These can in some cases be released easily. They are to be avoided in steep terrain.

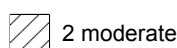
Full-depth avalanches

On steep grassy slopes full-depth avalanches are possible. They can be released at any time of day or night. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided as far as possible.

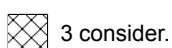
Danger levels



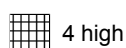

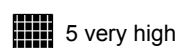
