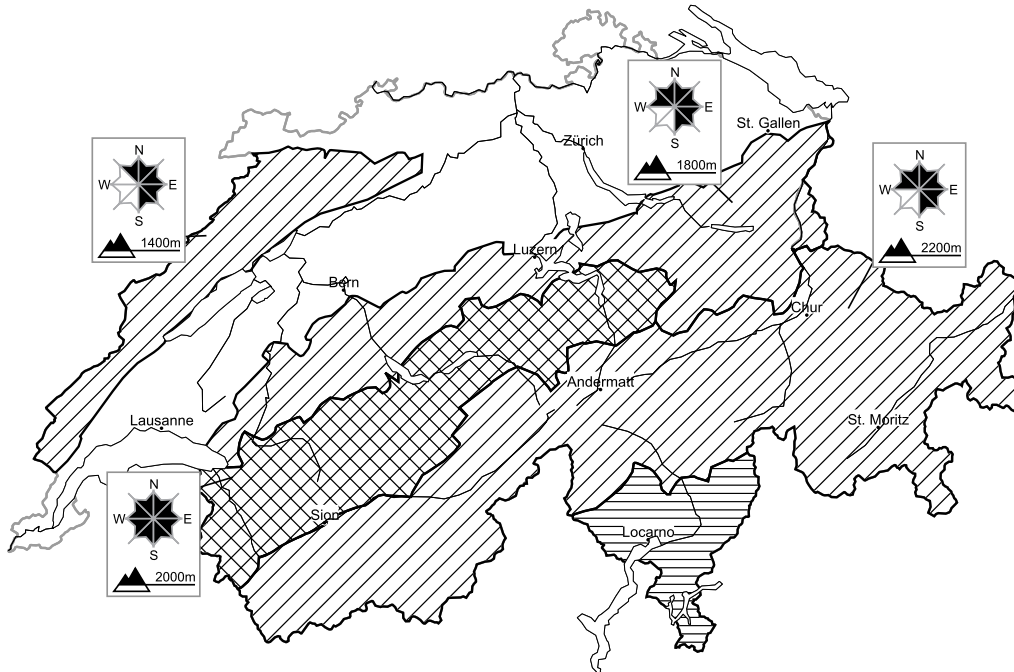


Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered in some regions. Fresh snow drifts require caution

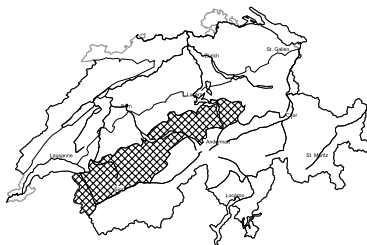

Avalanche danger



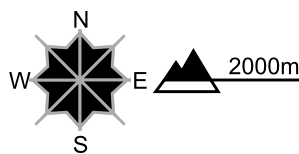
region A

Danger description

As a consequence of fresh snow and wind snow drift accumulations have formed. These are lying on the unfavourable surface of an old snowpack on shady slopes. Fresh snow and snow drift accumulations can be released, even by a single winter sport participant. The snow drift accumulations are covered with fresh snow in some cases and therefore difficult to recognise. Backcountry touring calls for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and careful route selection.

Full-depth avalanches

Small and medium-sized full-depth avalanches are possible. They can be released at any time of day or night. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided.
