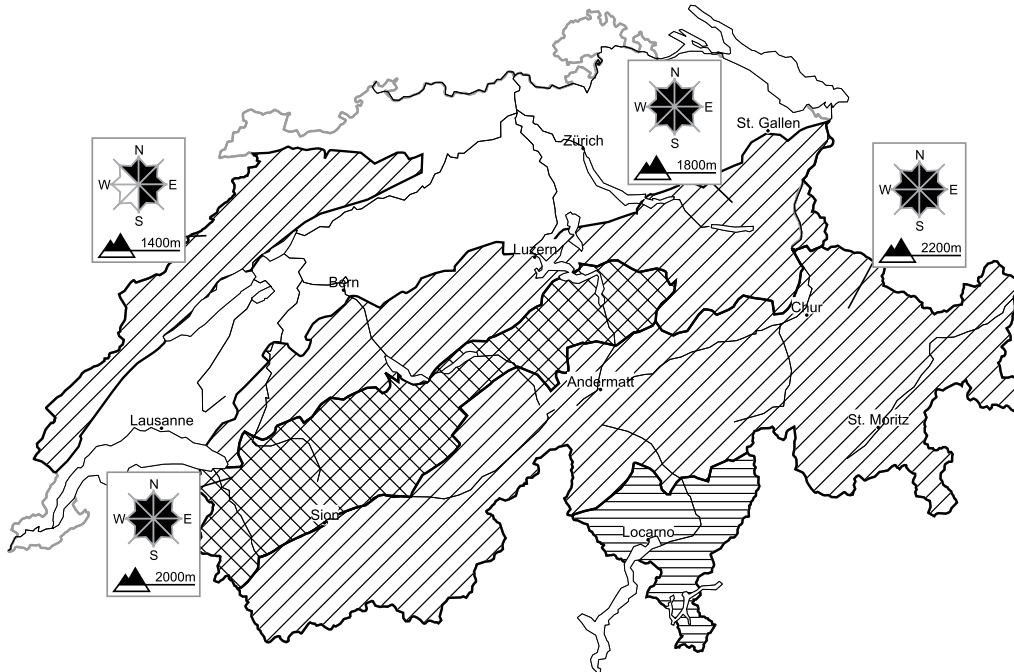


Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered in some regions. Fresh snow drifts require caution

Avalanche danger



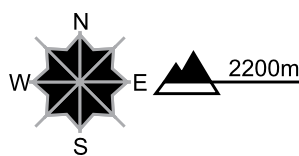
region C

Avalanche prone locations



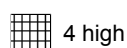
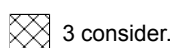
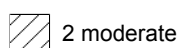
Danger description

As a consequence of fresh snow and wind small snow drift accumulations have formed. These are to be found in particular adjacent to the ridge line and in gullies and bowls. The snow drift accumulations can be released easily. They are to be avoided in very steep terrain. Apart from the danger of being buried, restraint should be exercised also in view of the danger of avalanches sweeping people along and giving rise to falls.

Full-depth avalanches

Small and medium-sized full-depth avalanches are possible. They can be released at any time of day or night. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided.
