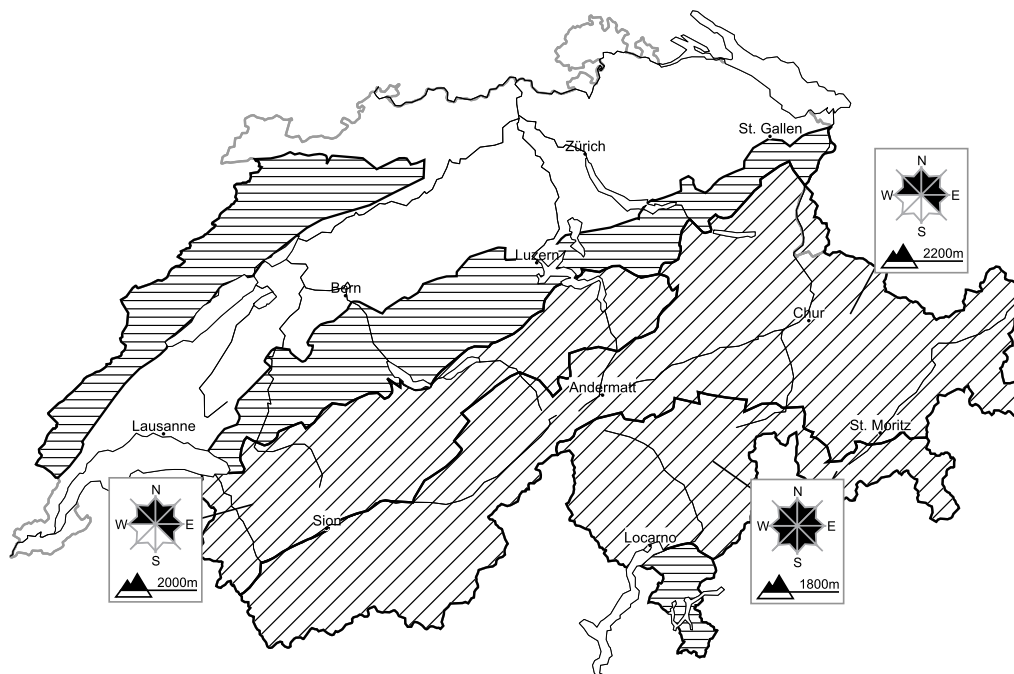

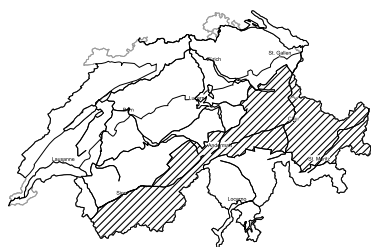

Avalanche danger



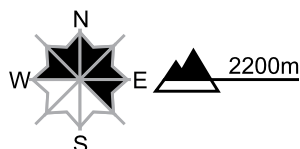
region C

Danger description

The somewhat older snow drift accumulations are to be found in particular adjacent to the ridge line and in gullies and bowls. These are mostly small but in some cases prone to triggering. Careful route selection is recommended. Apart from the danger of being buried, restraint should be exercised also in view of the danger of avalanches sweeping people along and giving rise to falls.

Full-depth avalanches

Individual small and medium-sized full-depth avalanches are possible. They can be released at any time of day or night. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided as far as possible.
