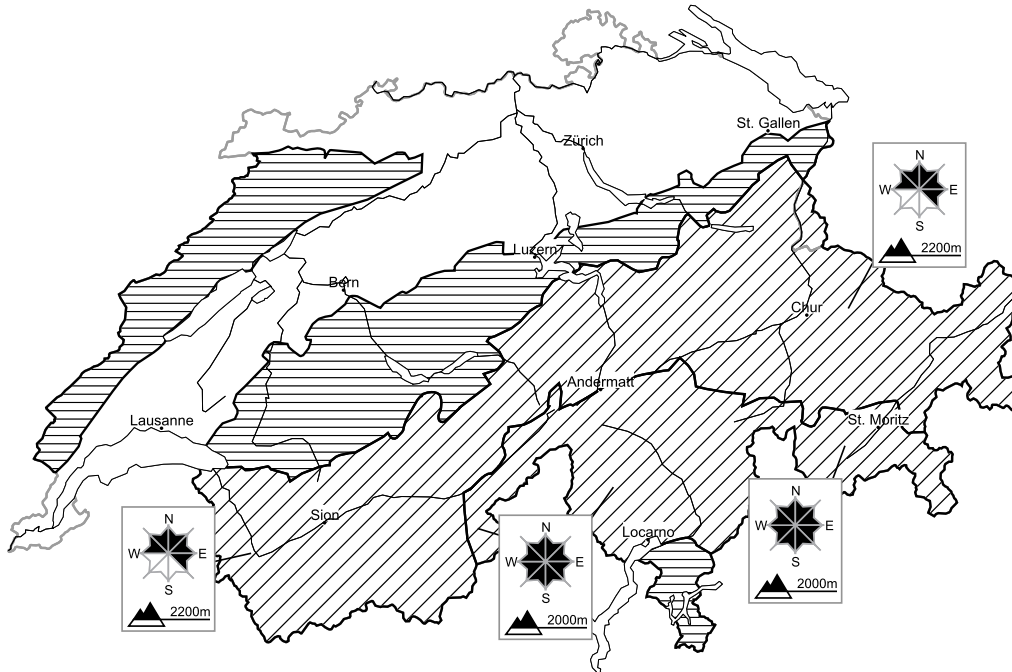


Moderate avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area. Snow drifts require caution

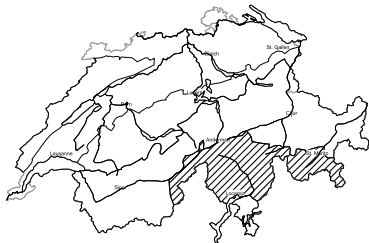

Avalanche danger



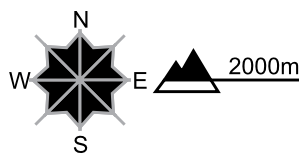
region A

Danger description

As a consequence of the northerly wind snow drift accumulations have formed. These are rather small but can be released easily. The number and size of avalanche prone locations will increase with altitude. The snow drift accumulations are to be avoided in steep terrain. Backcountry touring calls for careful route selection.

Full-depth avalanches

Individual small and medium-sized full-depth avalanches are possible, especially on east, south and west facing slopes below approximately 2400 m. They can be released at any time of day or night. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided as far as possible.
