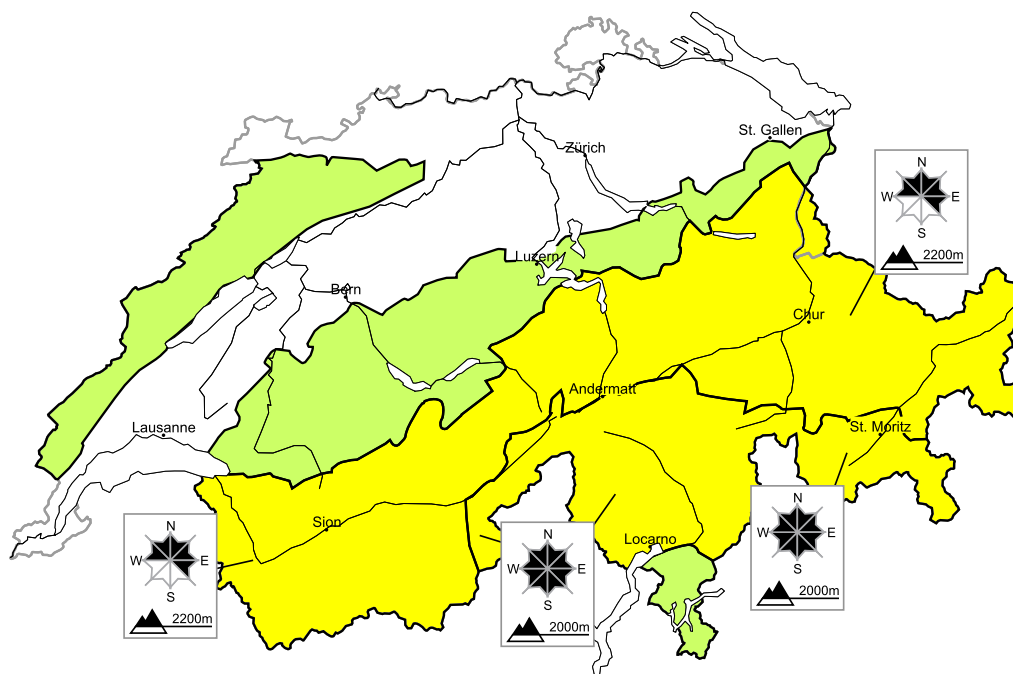


Moderate avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area. Snow drifts require caution

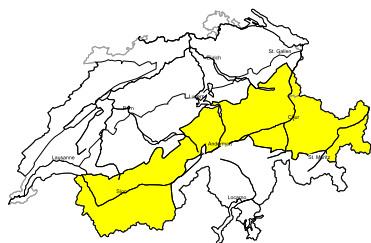

Avalanche danger



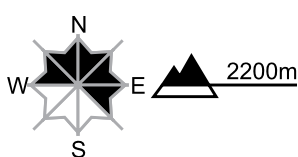

Danger description

The small snow drift accumulations of the last few days are in individual cases still prone to triggering. They are covered with fresh snow in some cases and therefore difficult to recognise. The avalanche prone locations are to be found in particular in gullies and bowls and adjacent to the ridge line in all aspects. Careful route selection is recommended. Apart from the danger of being buried, restraint should be exercised also in view of the danger of avalanches sweeping people along and giving rise to falls.

Full-depth avalanches

Individual small and medium-sized full-depth avalanches are possible, especially on east, south and west facing slopes below approximately 2400 m. They can be released at any time of day or night. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided as far as possible.

2 moderate

3 consider.

4 high

5 very high
