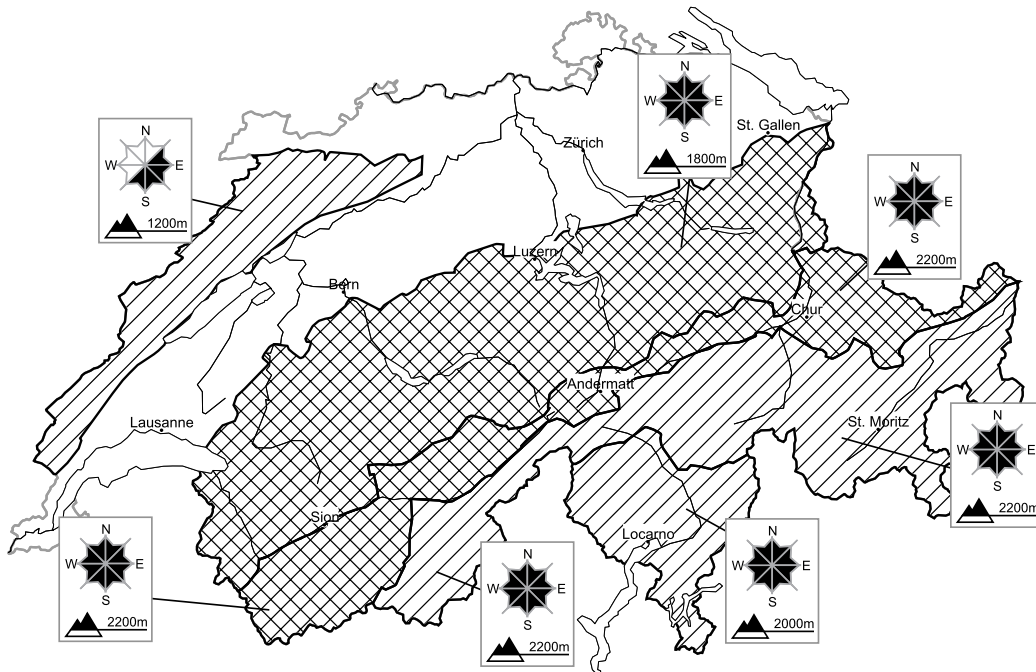


In the north a considerable avalanche danger will prevail. Snow drifts require caution

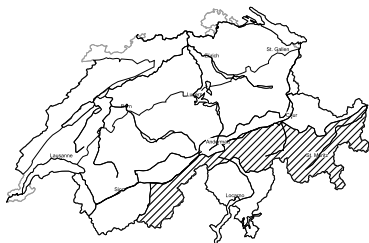

Avalanche danger



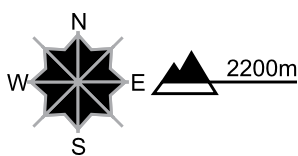
region C

Snow drifts

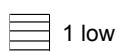
Avalanche prone locations



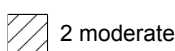
Danger description

Fresh snow drift accumulations are small but can be released easily. They are to be found adjacent to the ridge line and in gullies and bowls. The number and size of avalanche prone locations will increase with altitude. Apart from the danger of being buried, restraint should be exercised in particular in view of the danger of avalanches sweeping people along and giving rise to falls. Careful route selection is recommended.

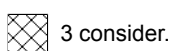
Danger levels



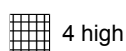

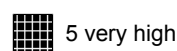
2 moderate
