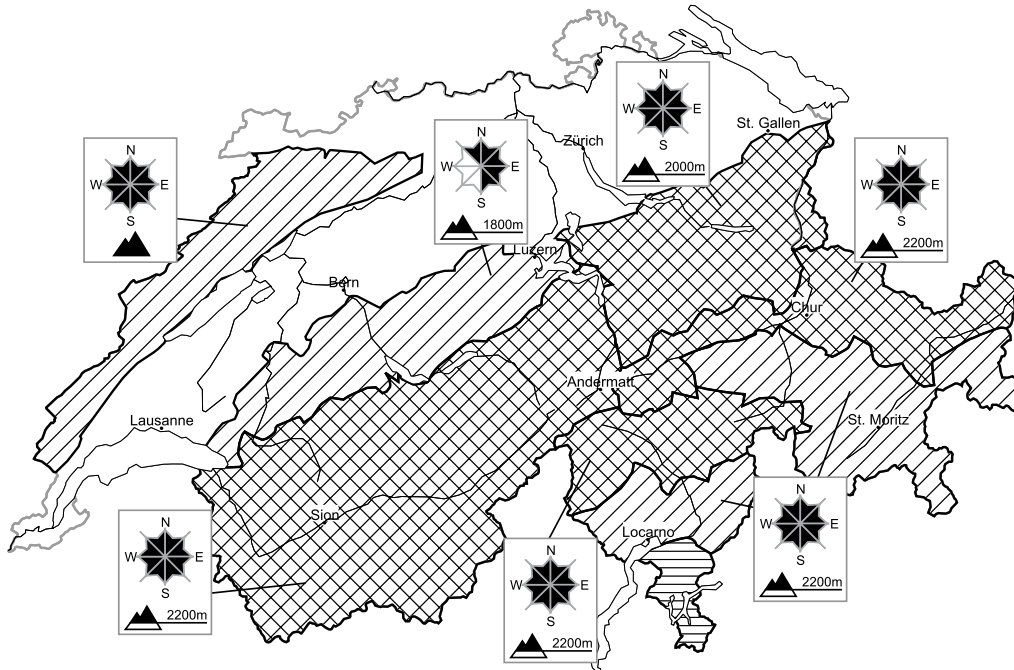


Outside marked and open pistes a considerable avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

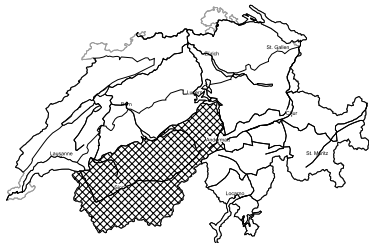

Avalanche danger



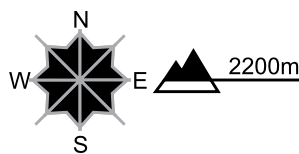
region A

Danger description

As a consequence of fresh snow and wind snow drift accumulations have formed. Single winter sport participants can release avalanches easily, including dangerously large ones. Natural avalanches are possible. Whumpung sounds and the formation of shooting cracks when stepping on the snowpack can indicate the danger. Snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger.

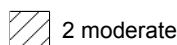
Wet and full-depth avalanches

As a consequence of the rain small and, in isolated cases, medium-sized full-depth and wet avalanches are to be expected below approximately 2200 m. Exposed parts of transportation routes can be endangered.

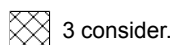
Danger levels



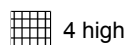

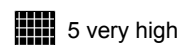
2 moderate
