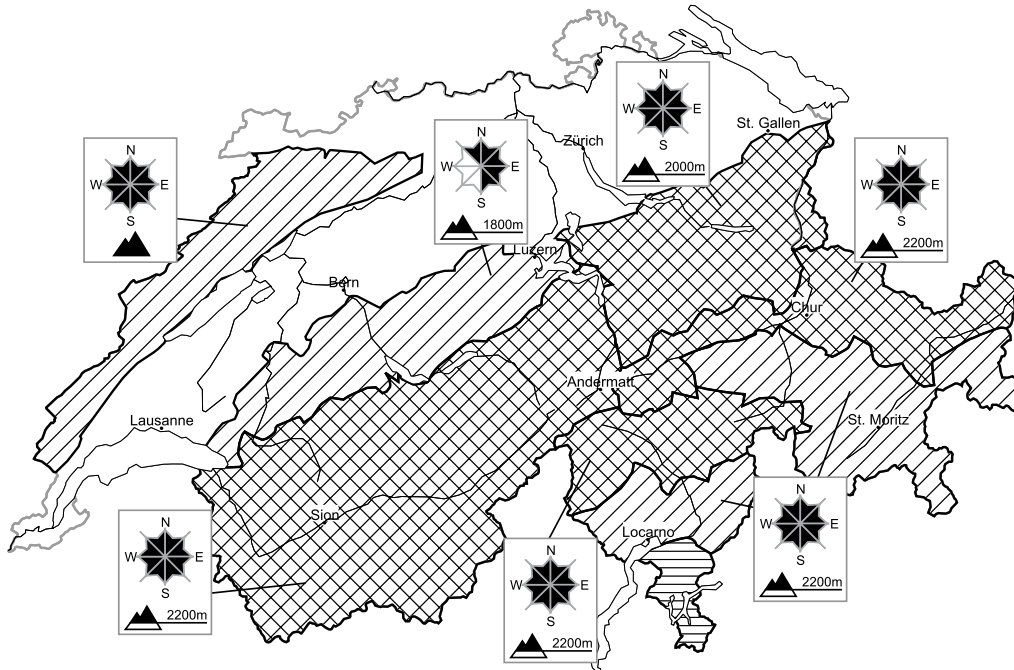


Outside marked and open pistes a considerable avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

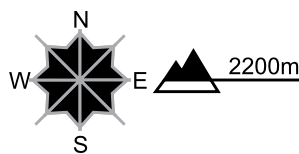

Avalanche prone locations



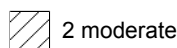
Danger description

As a consequence of fresh snow and wind snow drift accumulations have formed. Single winter sport participants can release avalanches easily. Mostly these are small. Whumping sounds and the formation of shooting cracks when stepping on the snowpack can indicate the danger. Snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and careful route selection.

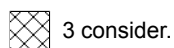
Danger levels



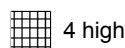

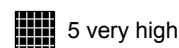
2 moderate
