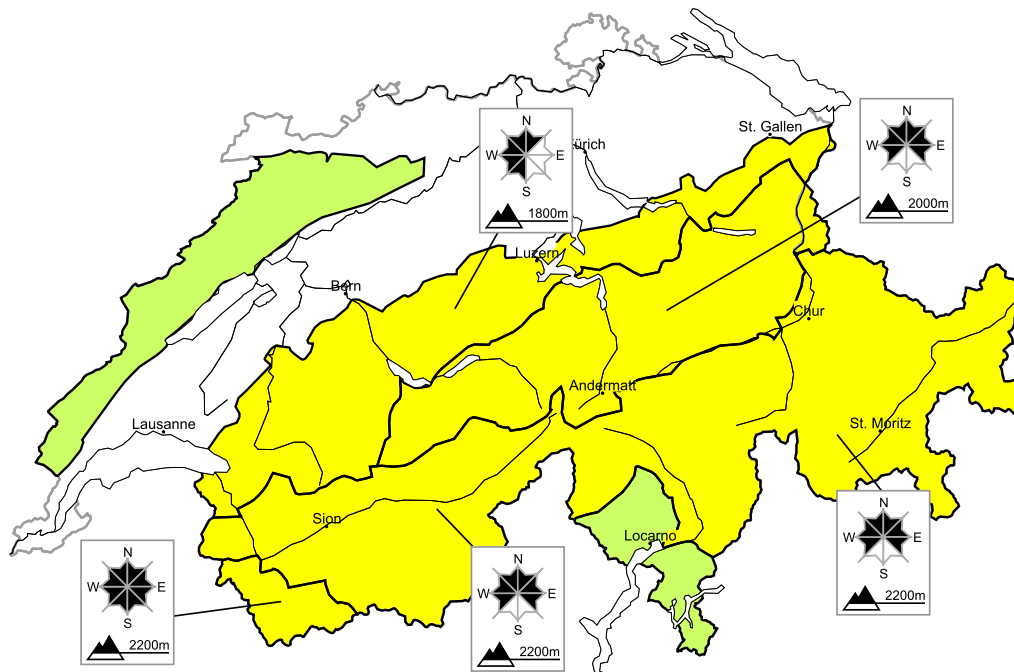

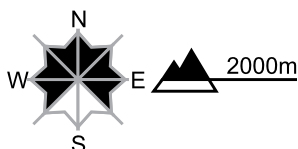


**region C** **Level 2, moderate**

#### Avalanche prone locations

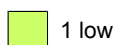


#### Danger description

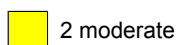
Weak layers in the upper part of the snowpack can be released by people in particular in little used backcountry terrain. The avalanche prone locations are rather rare but barely recognisable, even to the trained eye. Careful route selection is important.

As a consequence of the northeasterly wind clearly visible snow drift accumulations have formed. These are mostly small but can in some cases be released easily. They are to be avoided in particular in very steep terrain.

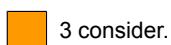

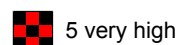
