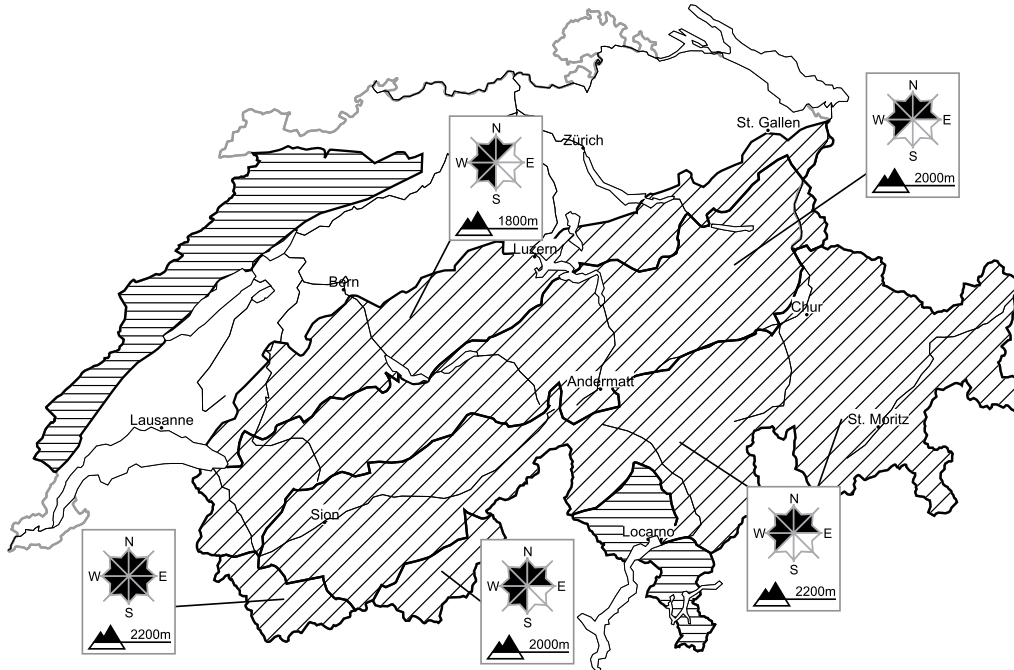

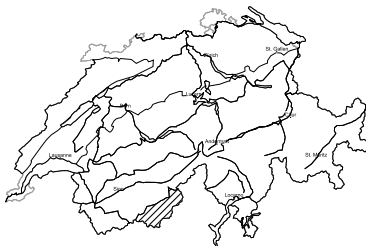

Avalanche danger



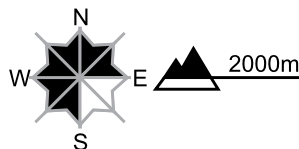
region A

Danger description

As a consequence of fresh snow and wind clearly visible snow drift accumulations will form. These will be deposited on the unfavourable surface of an old snowpack in particular on shady slopes. The fresh snow drift accumulations can be released, even by a single winter sport participant, but they will be small in most cases. They are to be avoided in steep terrain.
 Along the border with Italy: In localities where more than 20 cm of snow falls danger level 3 (considerable) will be reached.

Old snow

Weak layers in the upper part of the snowpack can be released by people in particular in little used backcountry terrain. These avalanche prone locations are to be found in particular on very steep shady slopes above approximately 2200 m. They are rather rare but barely recognisable, even to the trained eye. Careful route selection is important.
