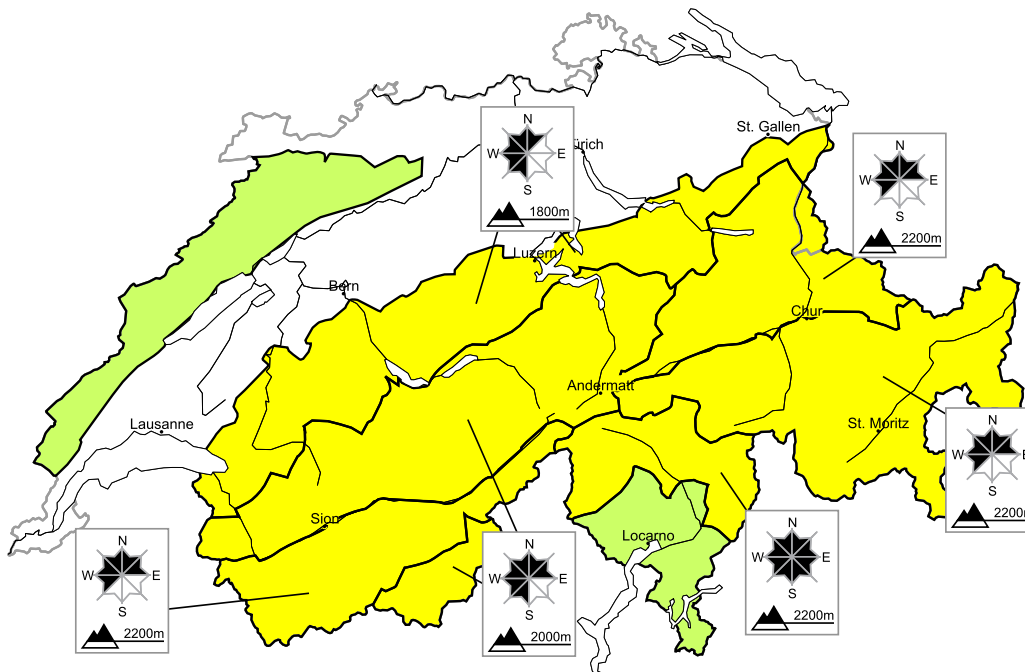


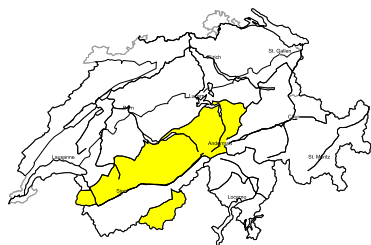

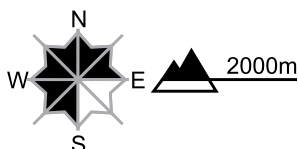


region B **Level 2, moderate**

Avalanche prone locations



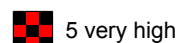
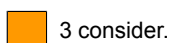
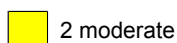
Danger description

Fresh and somewhat older snow drift accumulations can still be released in some cases. These are clearly recognisable to the trained eye. They must be evaluated with care and prudence. In high Alpine regions avalanche prone locations are more widespread and the danger is slightly greater.

Old snow

Weak layers in the upper part of the snowpack can be released by people in particular in little used backcountry terrain. This applies in particular above approximately 2400 m. These avalanche prone locations are rare but barely recognisable, even to the trained eye. Careful route selection is recommended.
