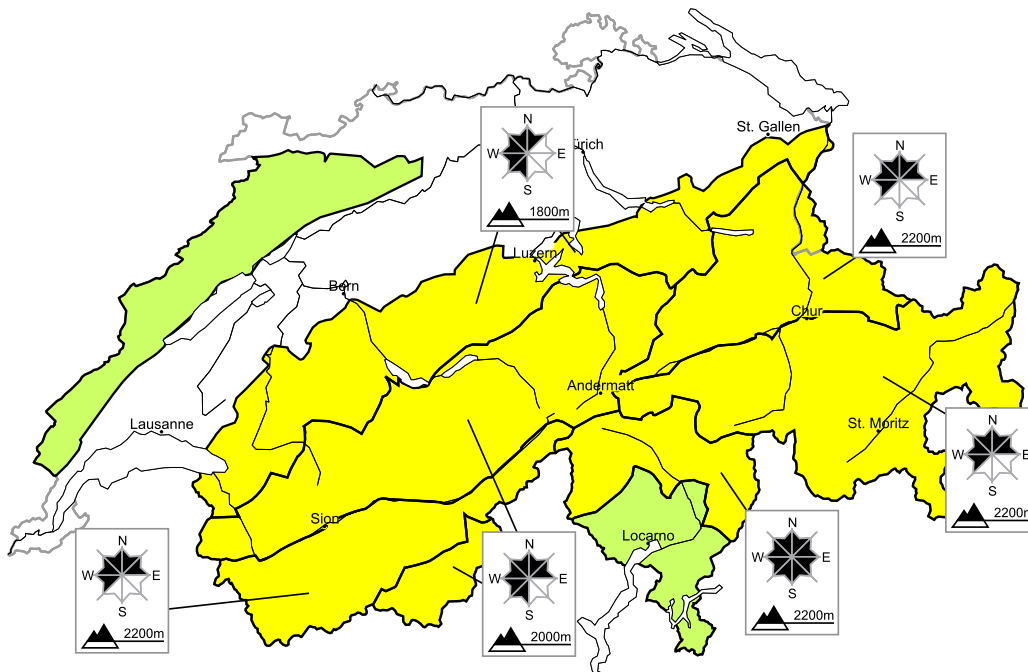


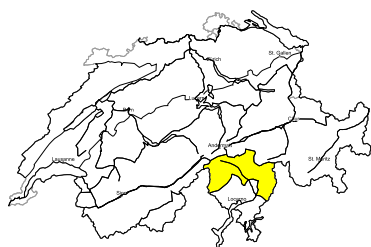

Avalanche danger

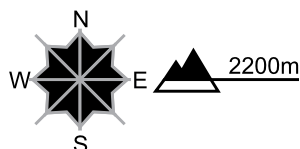


region D **Level 2, moderate**

Avalanche prone locations



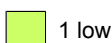
Danger description

As a consequence of the northerly wind snow drift accumulations will form. These are small but prone to triggering. They are to be evaluated with care and prudence in very steep terrain. Apart from the danger of being buried, restraint should be exercised also in view of the danger of avalanches sweeping people along and giving rise to falls.

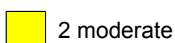
Old snow

Weak layers in the upper part of the snowpack can be released by people in particular in little used backcountry terrain. This applies in particular above approximately 2400 m. These avalanche prone locations are rare but barely recognisable, even to the trained eye. Careful route selection is recommended.

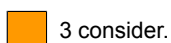
Danger levels



1 low



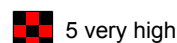
2 moderate
