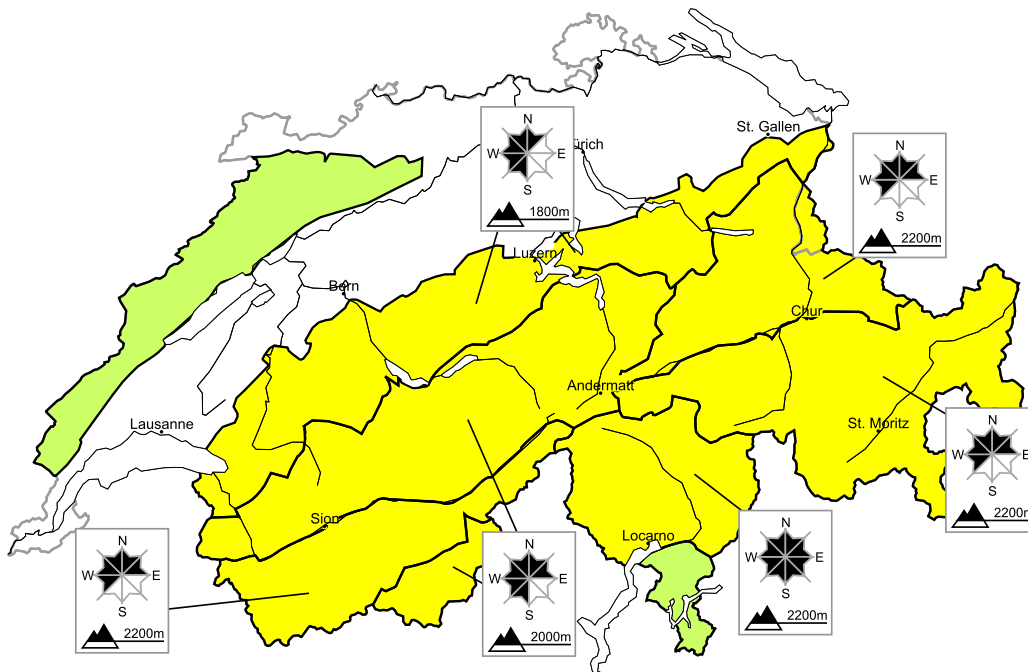


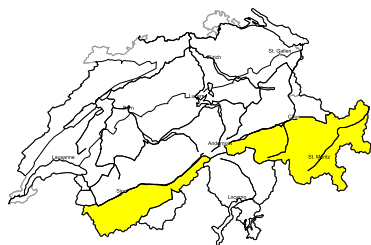
Moderate avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

Avalanche danger

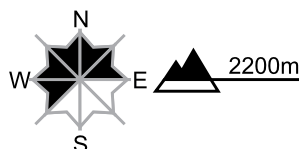


region C **Level 2, moderate**

Danger description

Weak layers in the upper part of the snowpack can be released by people in particular in little used backcountry terrain. The avalanche prone locations are rather rare but barely recognisable, even to the trained eye. Careful route selection is recommended.

Snow drifts

Fresh snow drift accumulations are small but can be released easily. They are clearly recognisable to the trained eye. They are to be evaluated with care and prudence in very steep terrain. Apart from the danger of being buried, restraint should be exercised also in view of the danger of avalanches sweeping people along and giving rise to falls.
