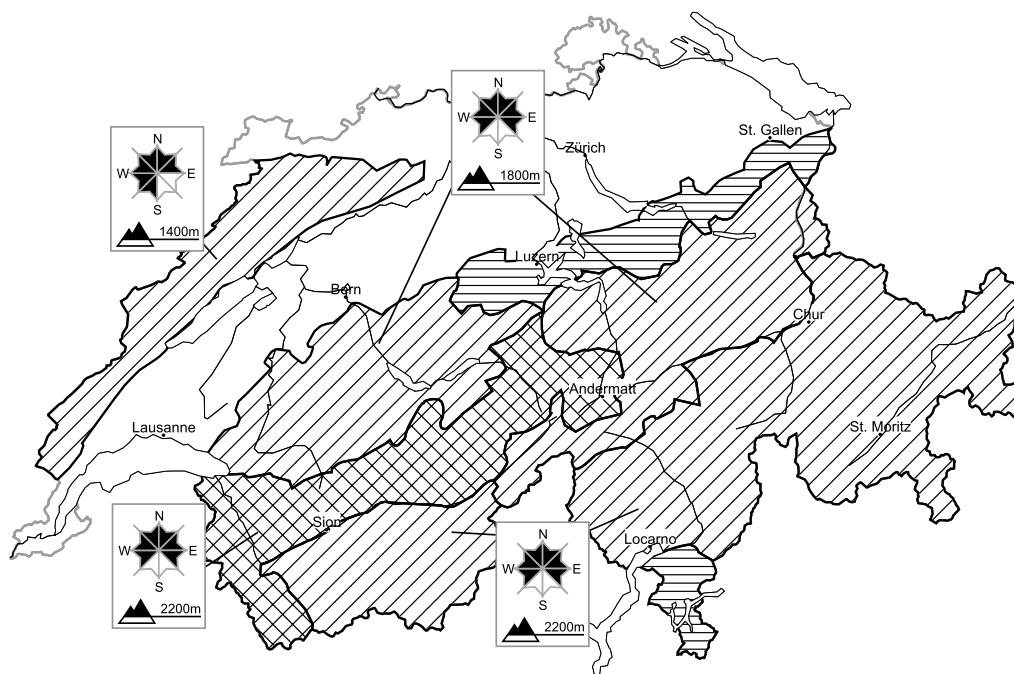

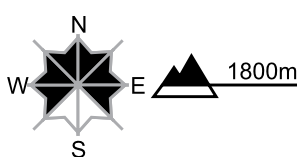

Snow drifts

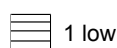
Avalanche prone locations



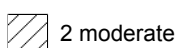
Danger description

As a consequence of the southerly wind brittle snow drift accumulations have formed. They are mostly small but can be released easily. The number and size of avalanche prone locations will increase as the day progresses. In very isolated cases avalanches can also release deeper layers of the snowpack. This applies especially in little used backcountry terrain. Meticulous route selection is recommended.

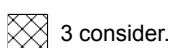

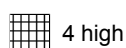

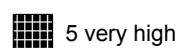
