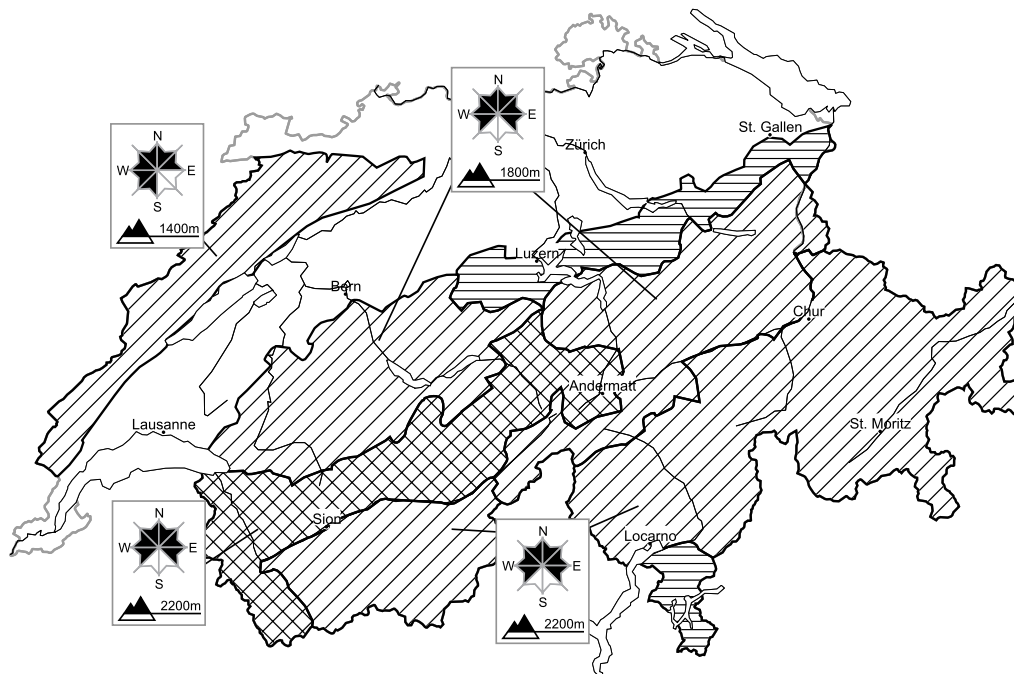

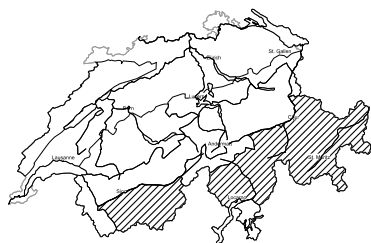

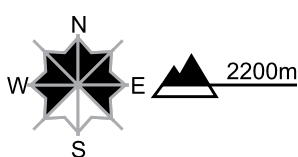

Snow drifts

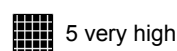
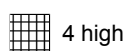
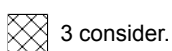
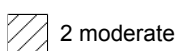
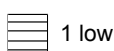
Avalanche prone locations



Danger description

As a consequence of the southerly wind brittle snow drift accumulations have formed. They are mostly small but can be released easily. Adjacent to the ridge line and in pass areas the snow drift accumulations are larger. Weak layers in the upper part of the snowpack can be released in isolated cases and mostly by large additional loads in particular in little used backcountry terrain. These avalanche prone locations are very rare but barely recognisable. Meticulous route selection is recommended.
