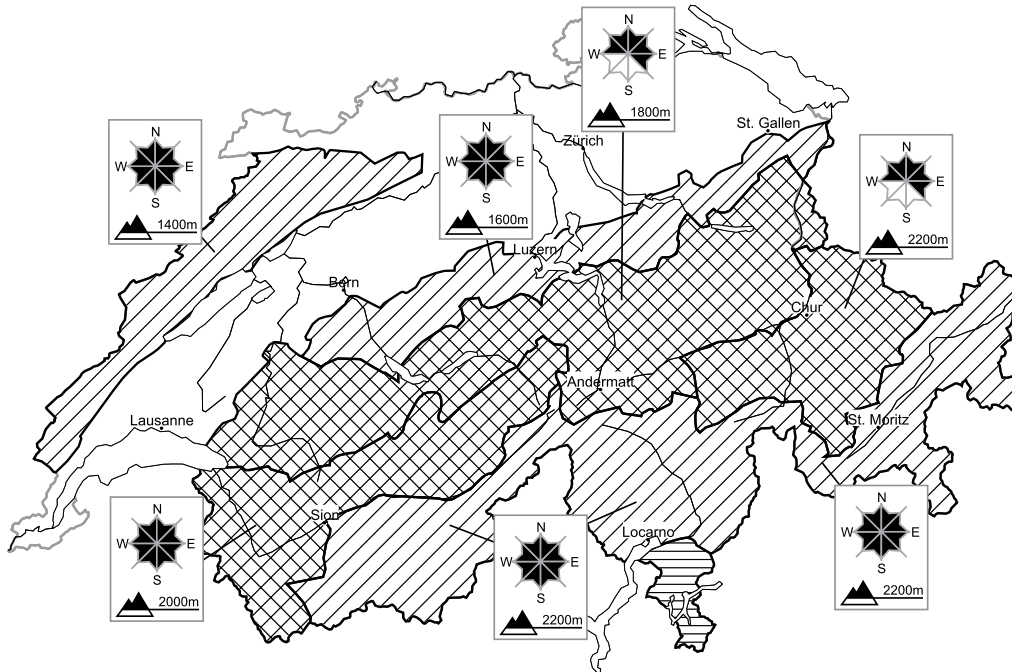


Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

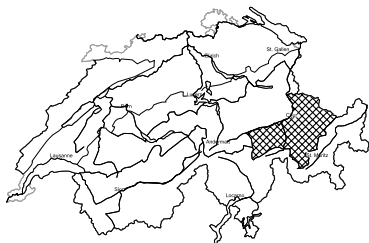

Avalanche danger



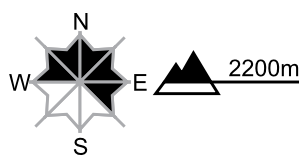
region C

Snow drifts

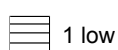
Avalanche prone locations



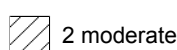
Danger description

As a consequence of fresh snow and wind the previously small snow drift accumulations will increase in size additionally. Even single snow sport participants can release avalanches. Mostly these are small. Whumpfung sounds and the formation of shooting cracks when stepping on the snowpack serve as an alarm indicating the danger. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and careful route selection.

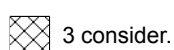
Danger levels



1 low



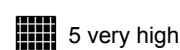
2 moderate
