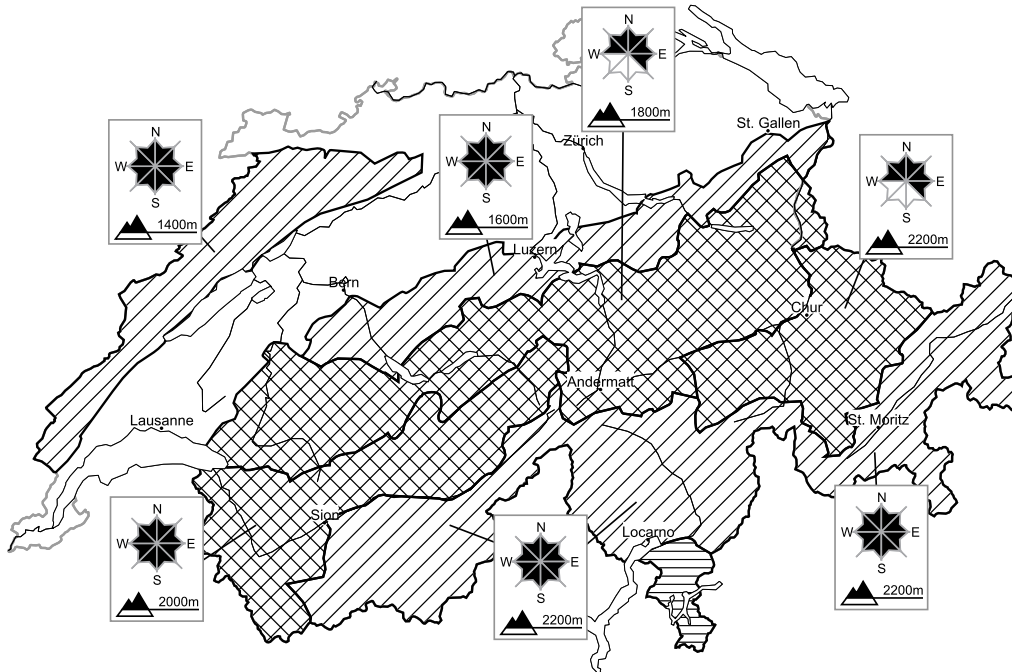

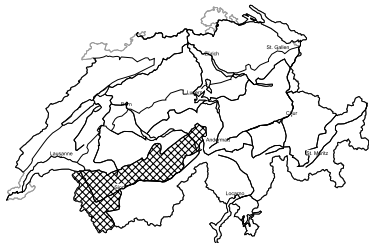

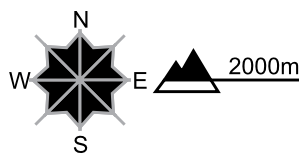
region A

Fresh snow and snow drifts

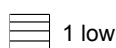
Avalanche prone locations



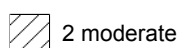
Danger description

The fresh snow and snow drift accumulations are prone to triggering. Single snow sport participants can release avalanches, including medium-sized ones. Whumphing sounds and the formation of shooting cracks when stepping on the snowpack serve as an alarm indicating the danger. Individual natural avalanches are possible. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and careful route selection.

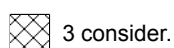
Danger levels



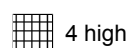

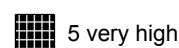
2 moderate
