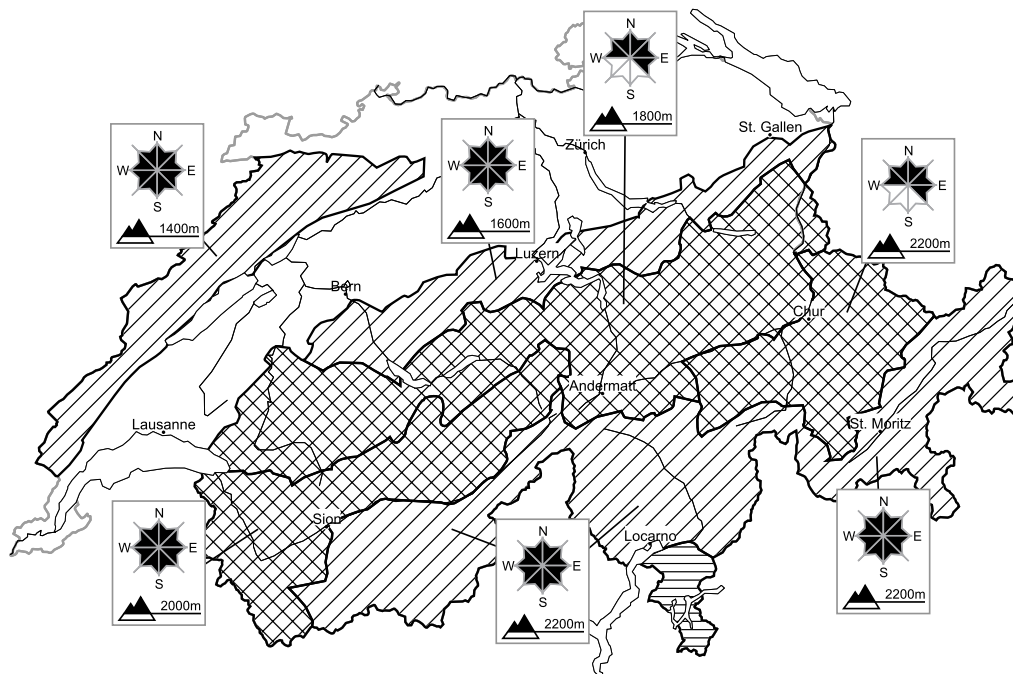

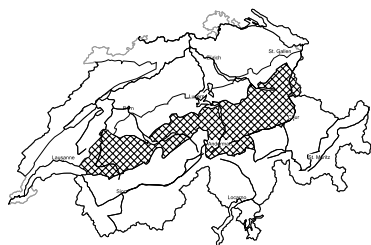

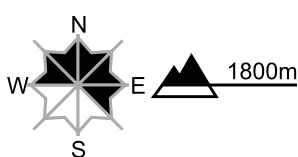

### Snow drifts

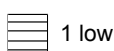
### Avalanche prone locations



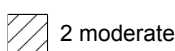
### Danger description

As a consequence of fresh snow and wind the previously small snow drift accumulations will increase in size additionally. Even single snow sport participants can release avalanches. The avalanche prone locations are sometimes covered with fresh snow and therefore difficult to recognise. Whumping sounds and the formation of shooting cracks when stepping on the snowpack serve as an alarm indicating the danger. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger.

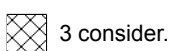

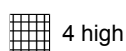

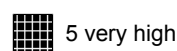
2 moderate
