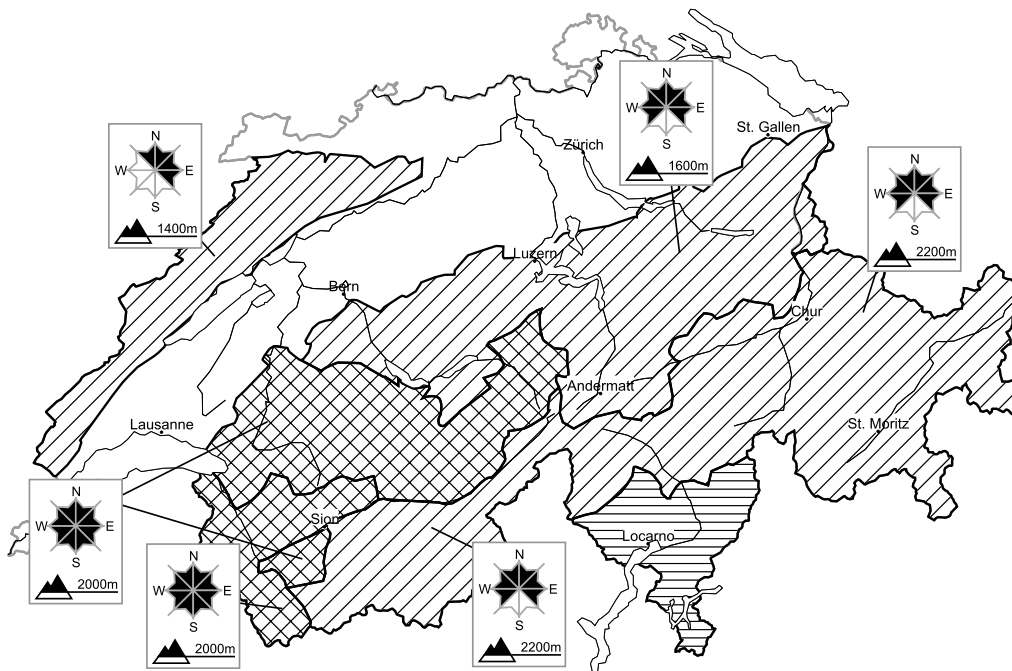


In the west a considerable avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area. Snow drifts require caution

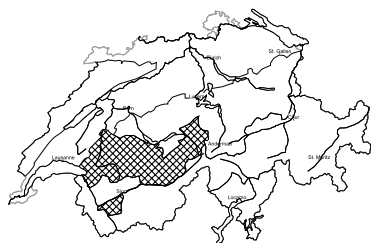

Danger description

The snow drift accumulations of the last few days are prone to triggering. These avalanche prone locations are covered with fresh snow and difficult to recognise. As a consequence of the foehn wind further snow drift accumulations will form. Single snow sport participants can release avalanches. They can reach medium size in isolated cases. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and careful route selection.

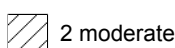
Wet avalanches as day progresses

On very steep sunny slopes mostly small moist snow slides and avalanches are to be expected as a consequence of warming during the day and solar radiation.

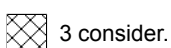
Danger levels



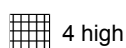
1 low



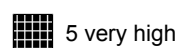
2 moderate
