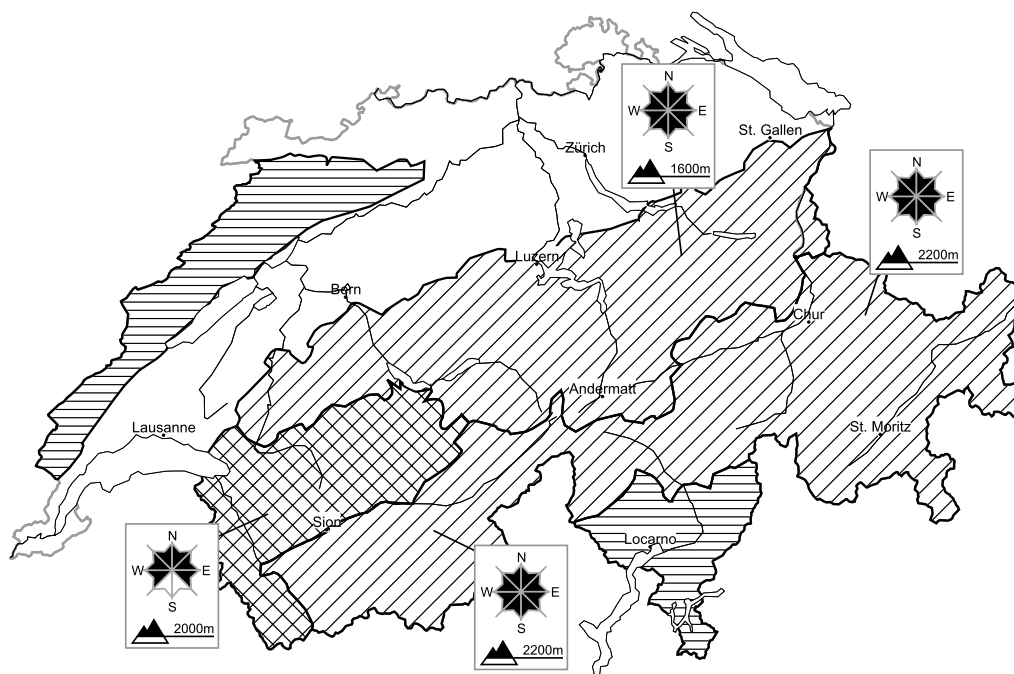


In the west a considerable avalanche danger will be encountered in some regions. Snow drifts require caution

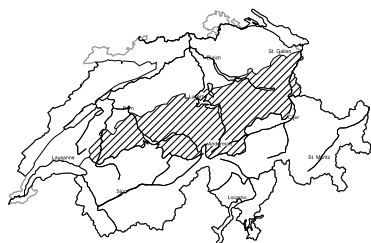

Avalanche danger



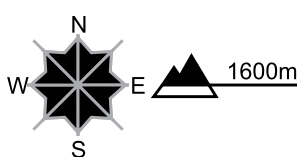

Danger description

The snow drift accumulations of the last few days represent the main danger. The avalanche prone locations are to be found in particular in gullies and bowls, and behind abrupt changes in the terrain. The number and size of avalanche prone locations will increase with altitude. Mostly avalanches are small but easily released. The snow drift accumulations are to be avoided in steep terrain. Apart from the danger of being buried, restraint should be exercised also in view of the danger of avalanches sweeping people along and giving rise to falls.

Wet avalanches as day progresses

On very steep sunny slopes small full-depth avalanches and moist snow slides are possible as a consequence of warming during the day and solar radiation.
