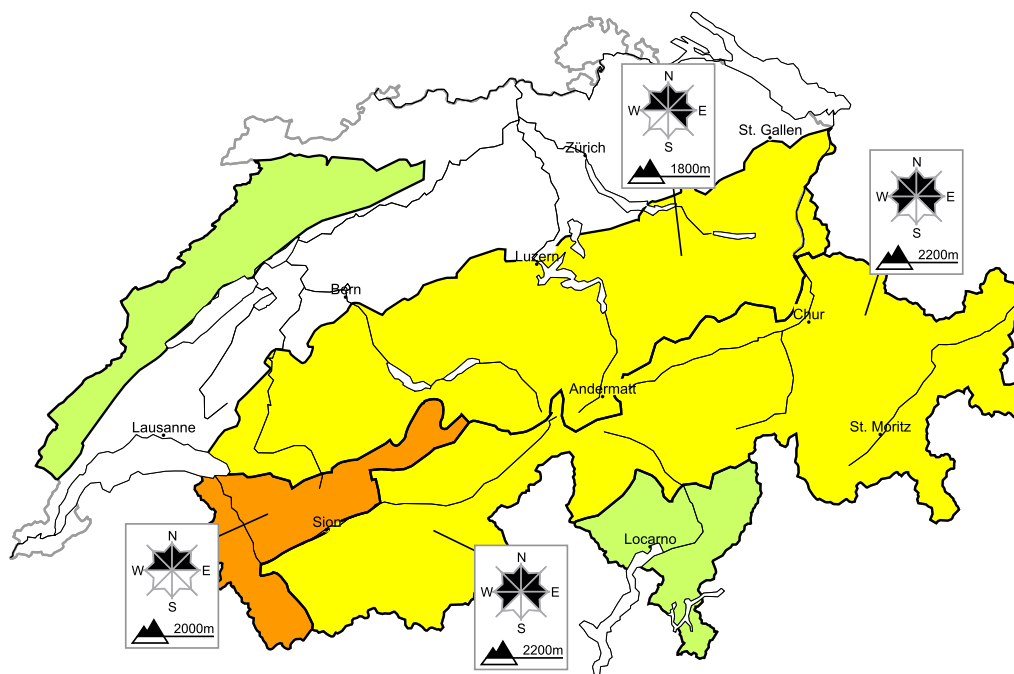

Avalanche danger



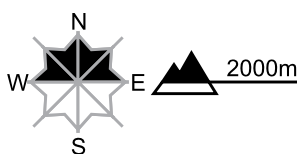
region A

Danger description

The somewhat older snow drift accumulations represent the main danger. They are bonding only slowly with the old snowpack in particular on steep shady slopes. Single snow sport participants can release avalanches. These can reach medium size in isolated cases. The avalanche prone locations are covered with fresh snow and difficult to recognise. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and careful route selection.
