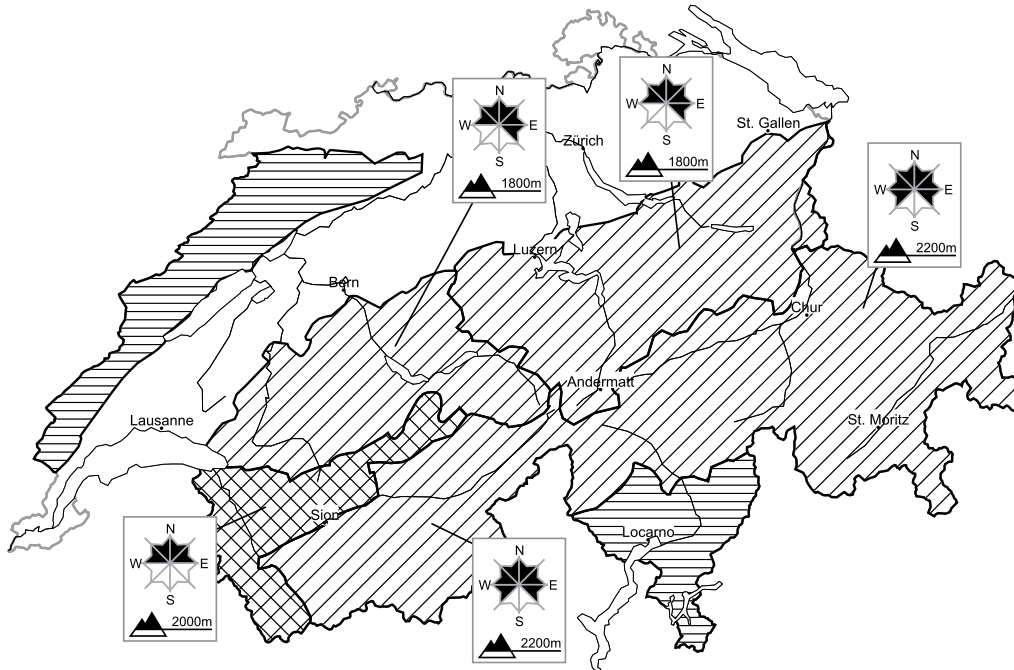


In the west a considerable avalanche danger will be encountered in some regions

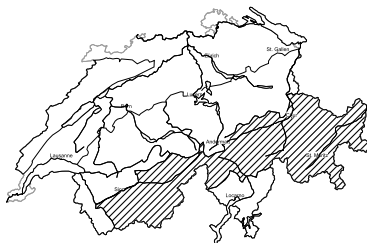

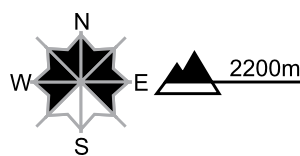

Snow drifts, old snow

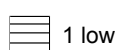
Avalanche prone locations



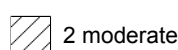
Danger description

The somewhat older snow drift accumulations represent the main danger. The avalanche prone locations are to be found in particular in gullies and bowls, and behind abrupt changes in the terrain. The number and size of avalanche prone locations will increase with altitude. Mostly avalanches are small but easily released. The avalanche prone locations are covered with fresh snow and difficult to recognise. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for careful route selection, especially on steep shady slopes.

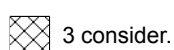

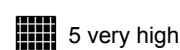
