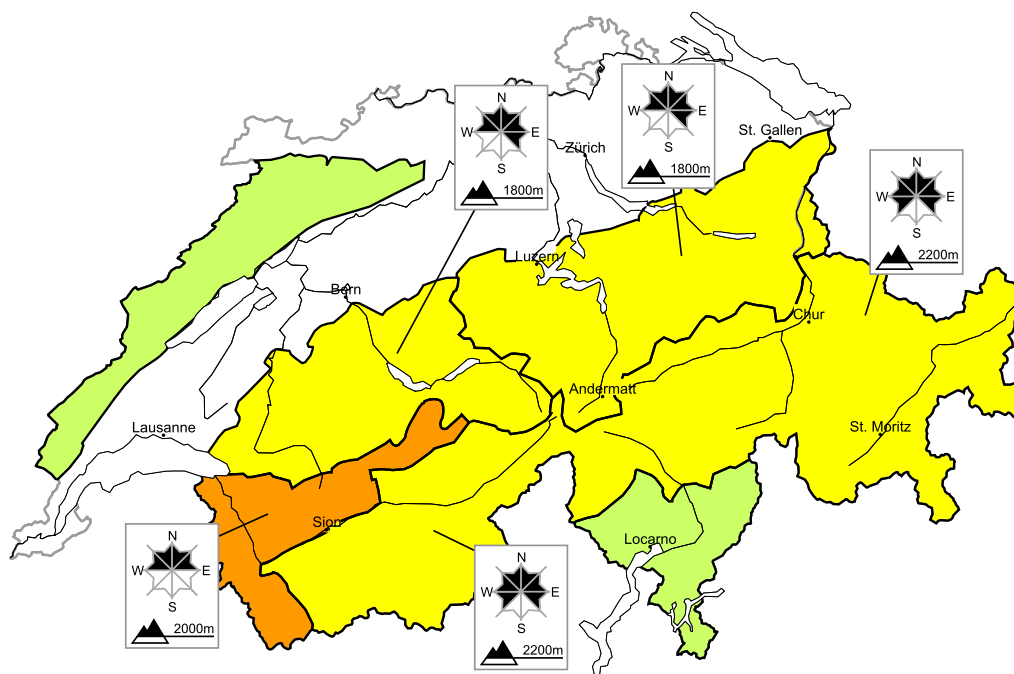


In the west a considerable avalanche danger will be encountered in some regions

Avalanche danger



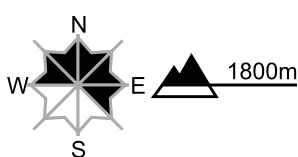

Danger description

The somewhat older snow drift accumulations represent the main danger. The avalanche prone locations are to be found in particular in gullies and bowls, and behind abrupt changes in the terrain. Mostly avalanches are small but easily released, especially on steep shady slopes.

As the day progresses as a consequence of the fresh snow there will be only a slight increase in the avalanche danger. The snow drift accumulations are covered with fresh snow and therefore barely recognisable.

Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for careful route selection.

3 consider.

4 high

5 very high
