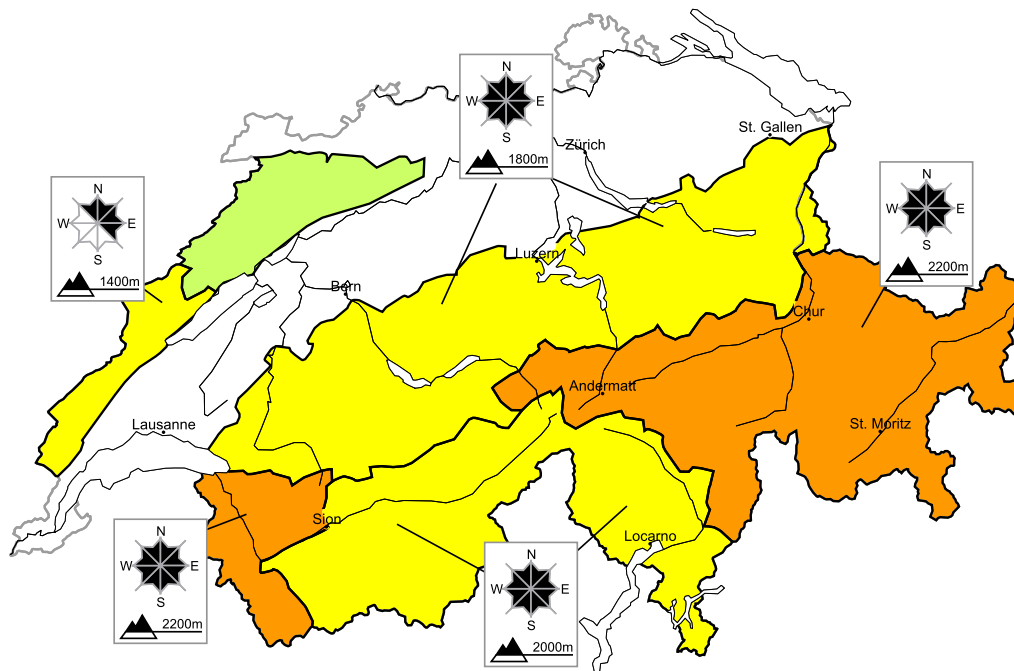


Slight increase in avalanche danger as a consequence of the snowfall

Avalanche danger



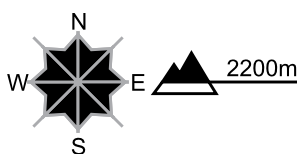
region B

Danger description

The older snow drift accumulations remain prone to triggering. These avalanche prone locations are covered with fresh snow and therefore barely recognisable. As a consequence of fresh snow and wind further snow drift accumulations will form. The danger level 3 (considerable) will be reached in the late morning probably. Single winter sport participants can release avalanches. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and careful route selection.

1 low

2 moderate

3 consider.

4 high

5 very high
