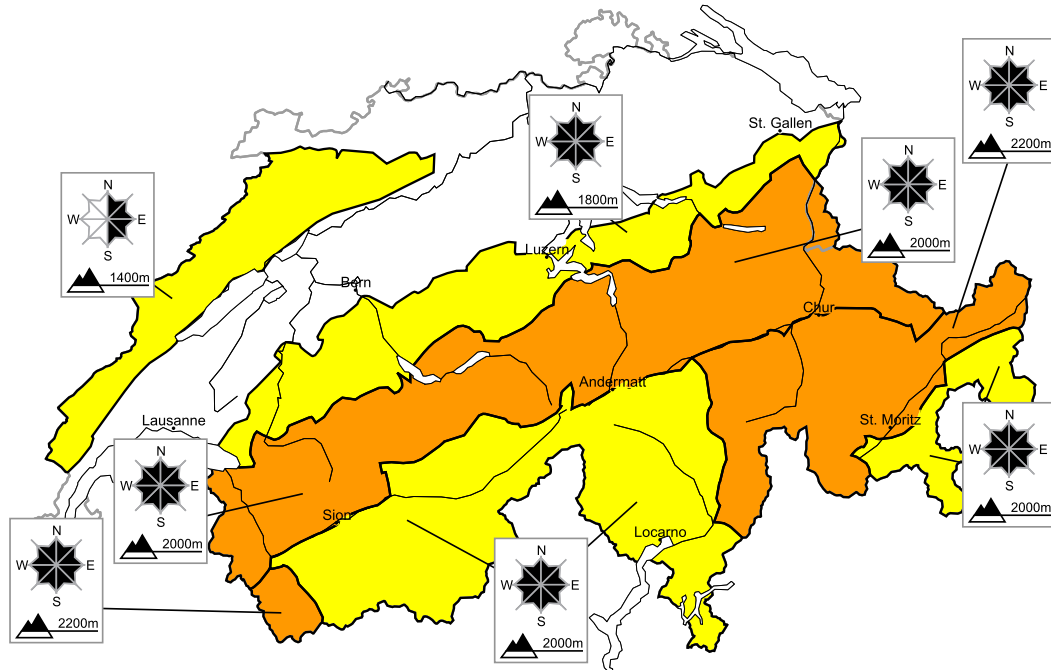


# Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered in some regions

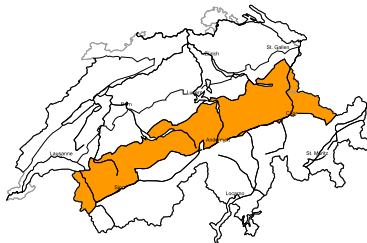

## Avalanche danger



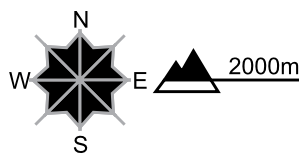
**region A**

### Fresh snow and snow drifts, old snow

#### Avalanche prone locations



#### Danger description

As a consequence of fresh snow and wind further snow drift accumulations have formed. At elevated altitudes the prevalence and size of the avalanche prone locations will increase. The older snow drift accumulations remain prone to triggering. These avalanche prone locations are covered with fresh snow and therefore barely recognisable. Single winter sport participants can release avalanches. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and careful route selection.

2 moderate

3 consider.

4 high

5 very high
