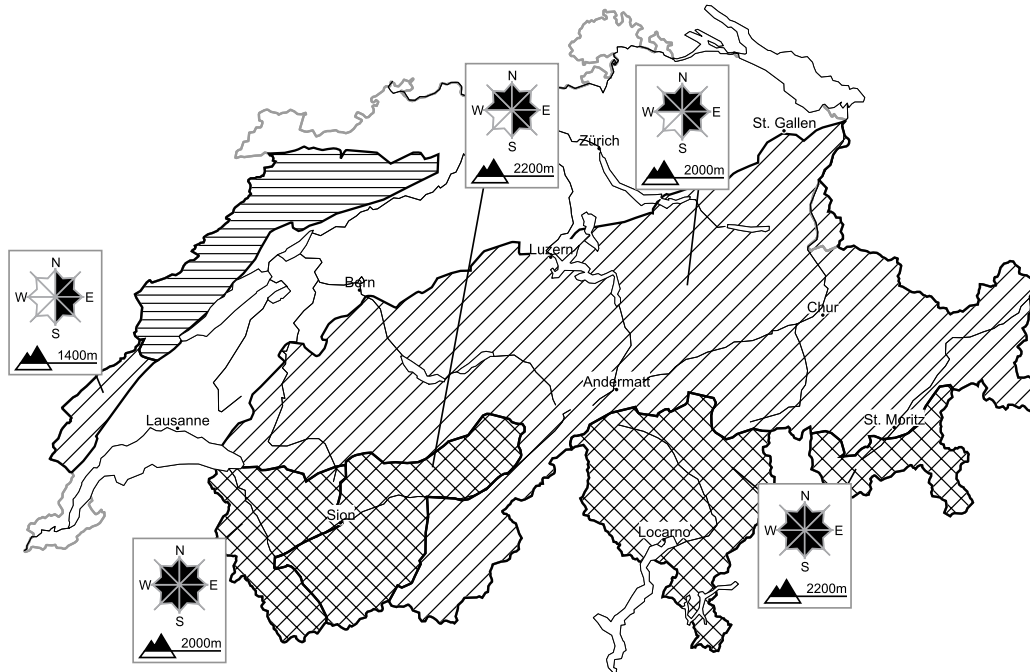


In the west and in the south a considerable avalanche danger will be encountered in some regions

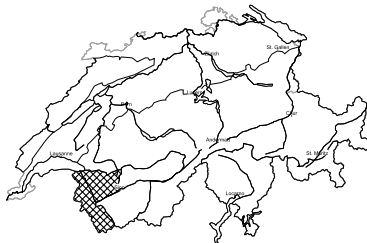

Avalanche danger



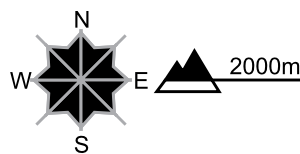
region A

Avalanche prone locations



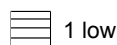
Danger description

Fresh snow and snow drift accumulations can over a wide area be released, even by a single winter sport participant and reach dangerously large size. Individual natural avalanches are to be expected. Somewhat older snow drift accumulations are covered with fresh snow and therefore barely recognisable. Caution is to be exercised on steep north facing slopes. Snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger.

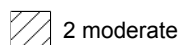
Full-depth avalanches

Below approximately 2400 m individual full-depth avalanches are possible, including quite large ones.

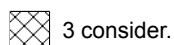
Danger levels



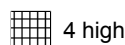
1 low
