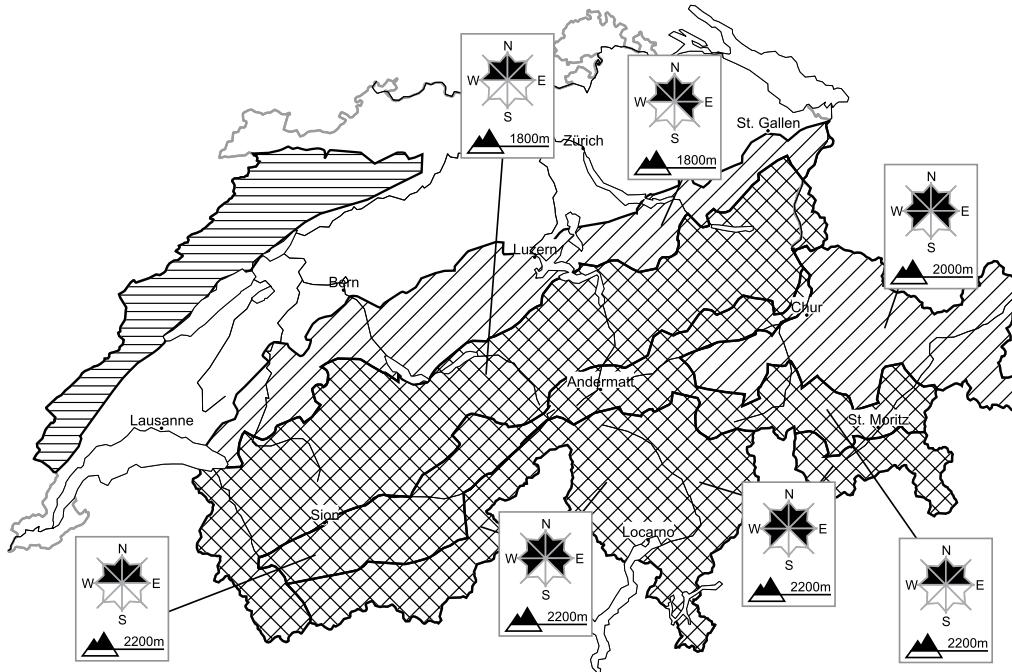


Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

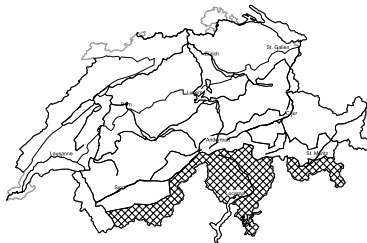

Avalanche danger



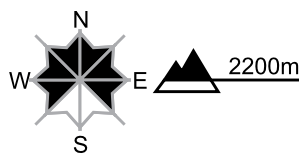

Danger description

Weak layers in the upper part of the snowpack can be released even by a single winter sport participant. Avalanches can reach medium size. As the day progresses as a consequence of fresh snow and wind there will be an increase in the avalanche danger within the current danger level. Snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and caution.

Full-depth avalanches

Below approximately 2400 m individual full-depth avalanches are possible, including quite large ones. Caution is to be exercised in areas with glide cracks.
