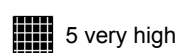
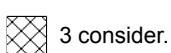
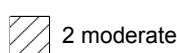
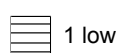


Weak layers in the upper part of the snowpack can be released by a single winter sport participant in some places. As a consequence of the southerly wind clearly visible snow drift accumulations will form. These are mostly small but can be released easily. Snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes call for careful route selection. The fresh snow drift accumulations are to be avoided as far as possible.

#### Full-depth avalanches

Below approximately 2400 m individual full-depth avalanches are possible, including medium-sized ones. Caution is to be exercised in areas with glide cracks.
