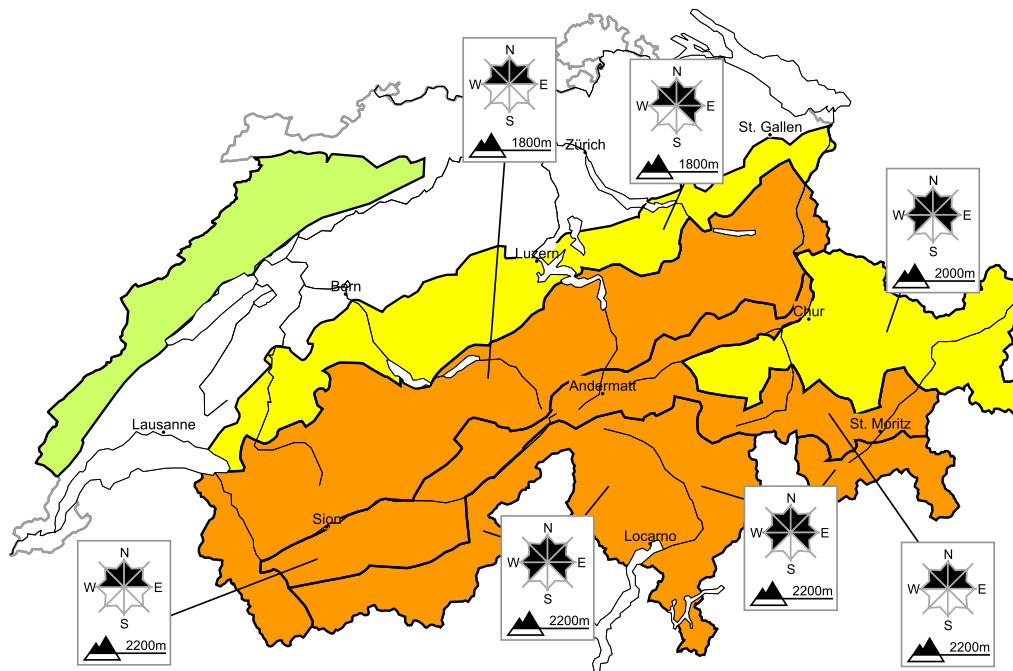


Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

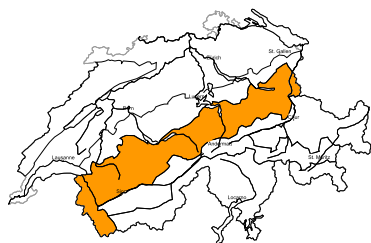

Avalanche danger



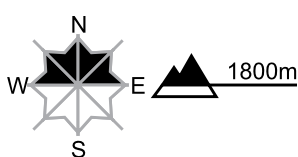
region A

Danger description

The fresh snow and snow drift accumulations of the last few days are prone to triggering in particular on steep shady slopes. As a consequence of the foehn wind from the south further snow drift accumulations will form. The fresh snow drift accumulations are very prone to triggering. Single snow sport participants can release avalanches, including medium-sized ones. Individual natural avalanches are possible. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger. Fresh snow drift accumulations are to be avoided.

Wet avalanches as day progresses, Full-depth avalanches

On steep sunny slopes full-depth and wet avalanches are possible. Caution is to be exercised in areas with glide cracks.
