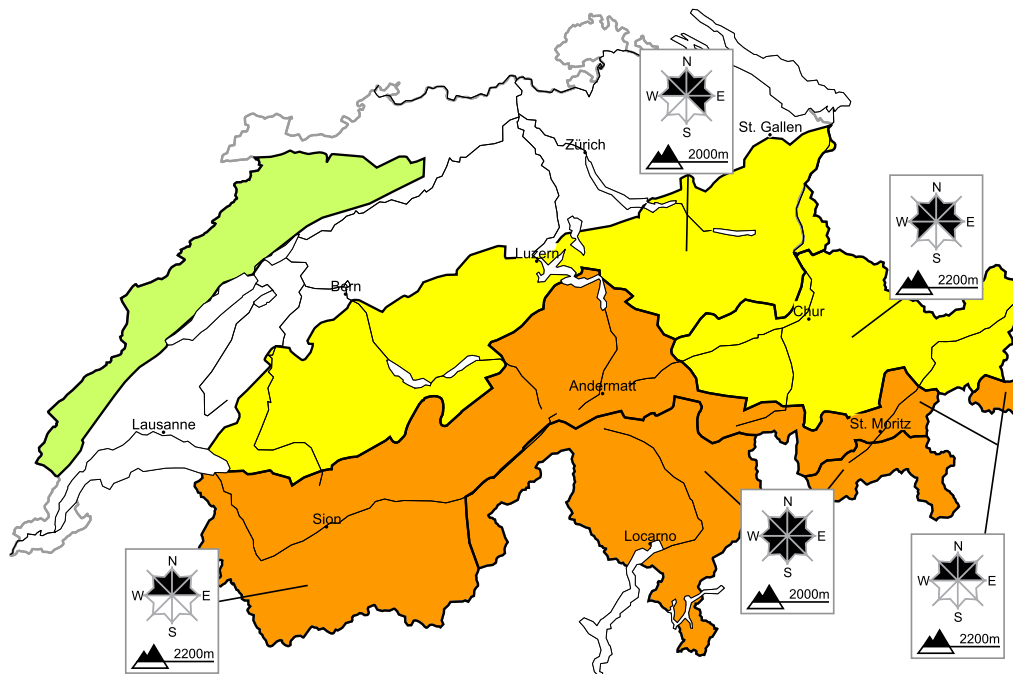


Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

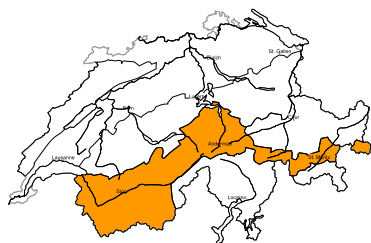

Avalanche danger



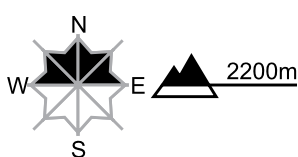
region B

Danger description

The snow drift accumulations of the last few days are in some cases still prone to triggering. Mostly these are small. The avalanche prone locations are sometimes covered with fresh snow and therefore difficult to recognise.

Avalanches can additionally in some places be released in deeper layers. Caution is to be exercised in particular on steep north facing slopes. Single snow sport participants can release avalanches. Snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and careful route selection. The conditions are treacherous.

Full-depth avalanches

Below approximately 2400 m more full-depth avalanches are possible, including quite large ones. Caution is to be exercised in areas with glide cracks.

1 low

2 moderate

3 consider.

4 high

5 very high
