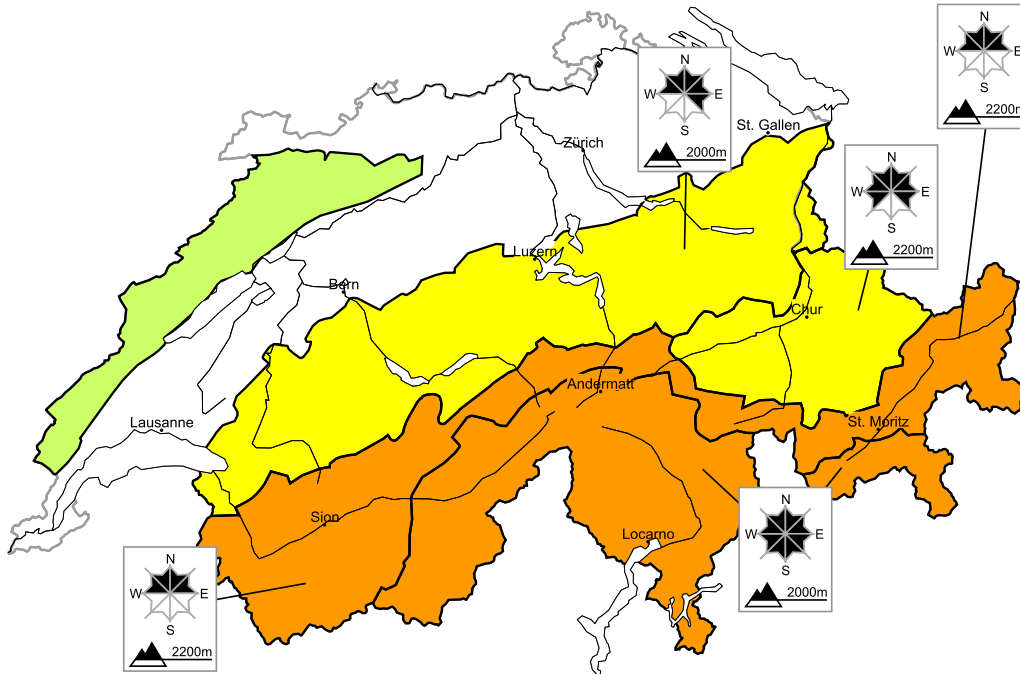


# As a consequence of fresh snow a critical avalanche situation will be encountered in some regions

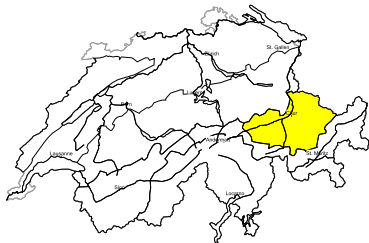

## Avalanche danger



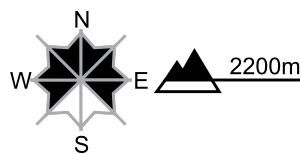
**region C**

#### Avalanche prone locations



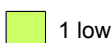
#### Danger description

Weak layers in the upper part of the snowpack can be released by a single winter sport participant in some places. Fresh and somewhat older snow drift accumulations are to be found in particular adjacent to the ridge line and in pass areas. These are mostly small but can be released easily. Snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes call for careful route selection.

### Full-depth avalanches

Below approximately 2400 m individual full-depth avalanches are possible, including quite large ones. Caution is to be exercised in areas with glide cracks.

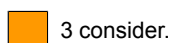

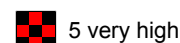
