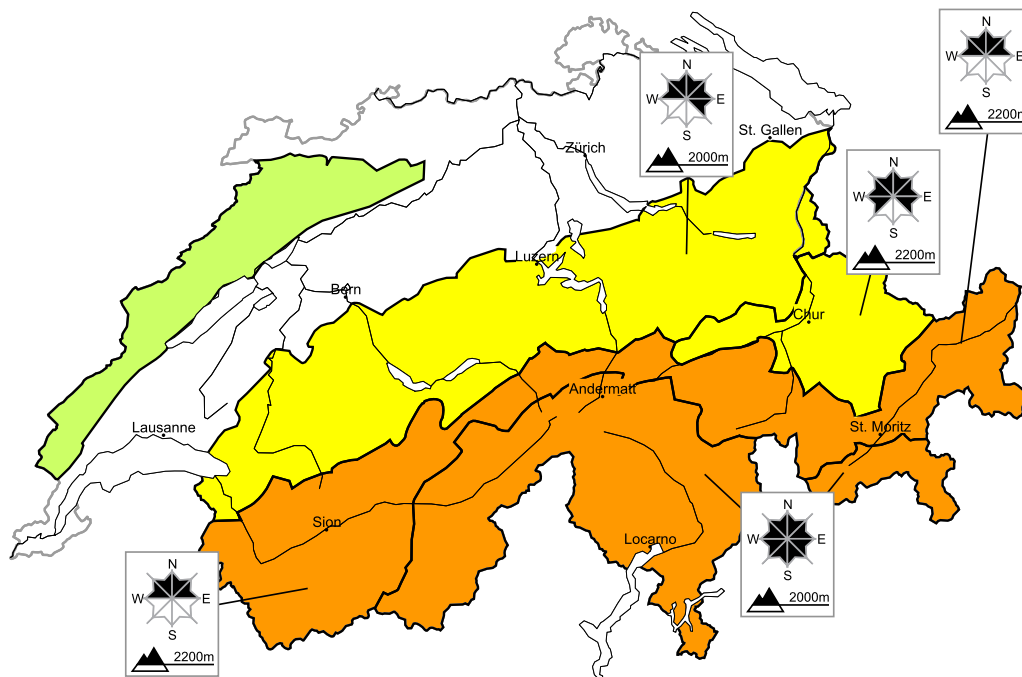


As a consequence of fresh snow a critical avalanche situation will be encountered in some regions

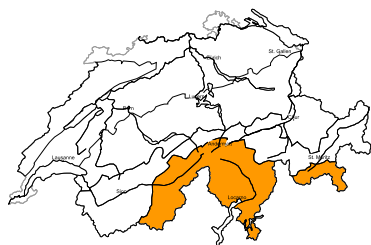

Avalanche danger



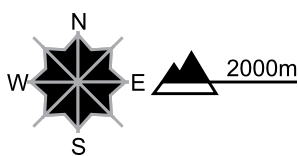
region A

Danger description

The fresh snow and snow drift accumulations are lying on the unfavourable surface of an old snowpack. Avalanches can additionally in some places be released in deeper layers, especially on steep north facing slopes. Single snow sport participants can release avalanches, including medium-sized ones. Individual natural avalanches are possible. Snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and caution.

Full-depth avalanches

Below approximately 2400 m more full-depth avalanches are possible, including quite large ones. Caution is to be exercised in areas with glide cracks.

1 low

2 moderate

3 consider.

4 high

5 very high
