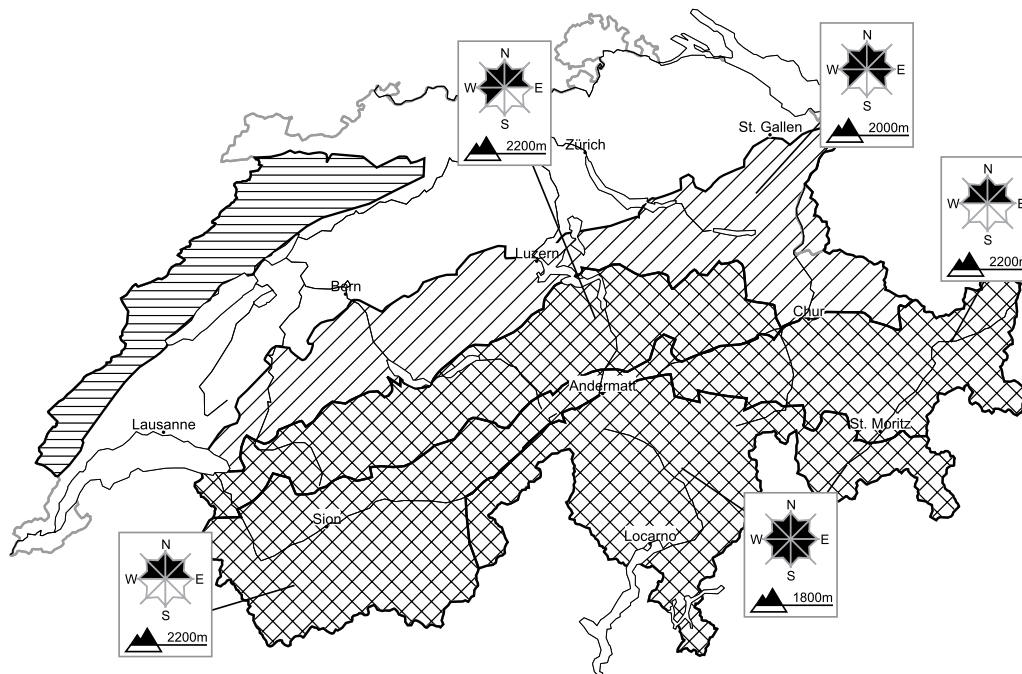


# A critical avalanche situation will be encountered in some regions. Fresh snow drifts require caution

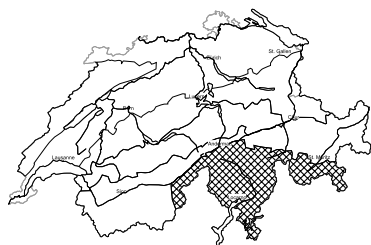

## Avalanche danger



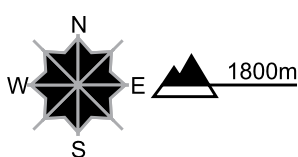
### region A

##### Danger description

A critical avalanche situation will prevail. As a consequence of the northerly wind extensive snow drift accumulations will form. The fresh snow and snow drift accumulations are poorly bonded with the old snowpack. To some extent avalanches can also be released in the old snowpack, especially on steep north facing slopes. Single snow sport participants can release avalanches easily, including medium-sized ones. Individual natural avalanches are possible. Snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes call for extensive experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and great restraint.

#### Full-depth avalanches

Below approximately 2400 m individual full-depth avalanches are possible, including quite large ones. Caution is to be exercised in areas with glide cracks.
