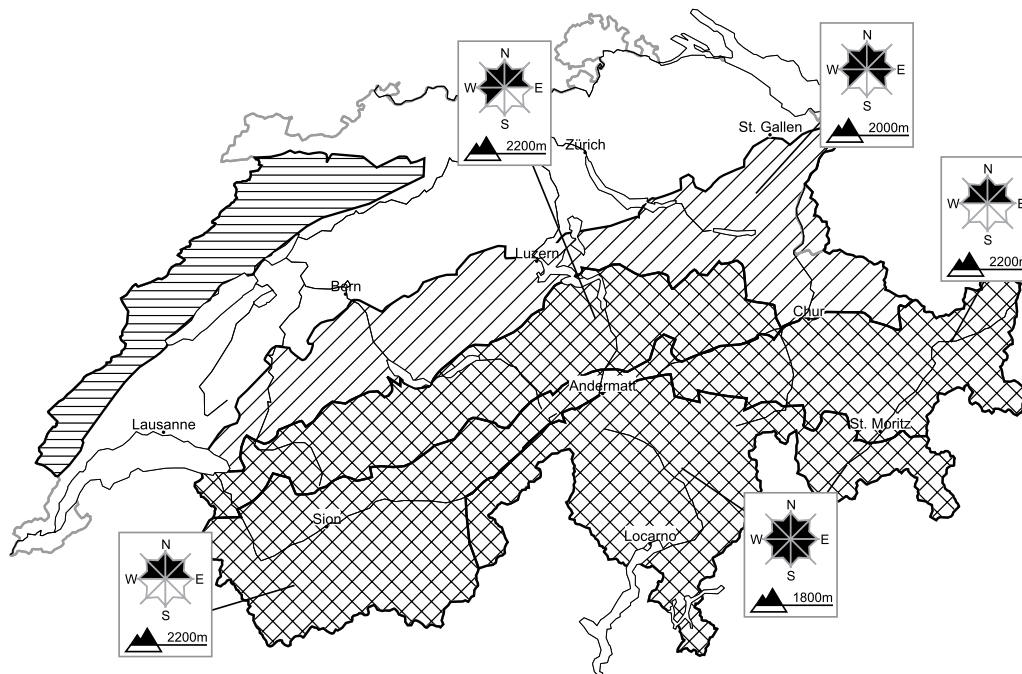


A critical avalanche situation will be encountered in some regions. Fresh snow drifts require caution

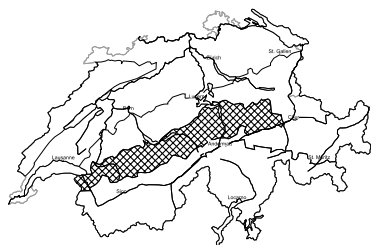

Avalanche danger



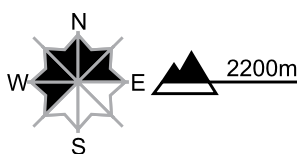
region C

Danger description

The fresh snow and snow drift accumulations are poorly bonded with the old snowpack in particular on steep shady slopes. Fresh snow drift accumulations will form in particular adjacent to the ridge line. Single winter sport participants can release avalanches in some places. Off-piste activities call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and careful route selection.

Full-depth avalanches

Below approximately 2400 m individual full-depth avalanches are possible, including quite large ones. Caution is to be exercised in areas with glide cracks.
