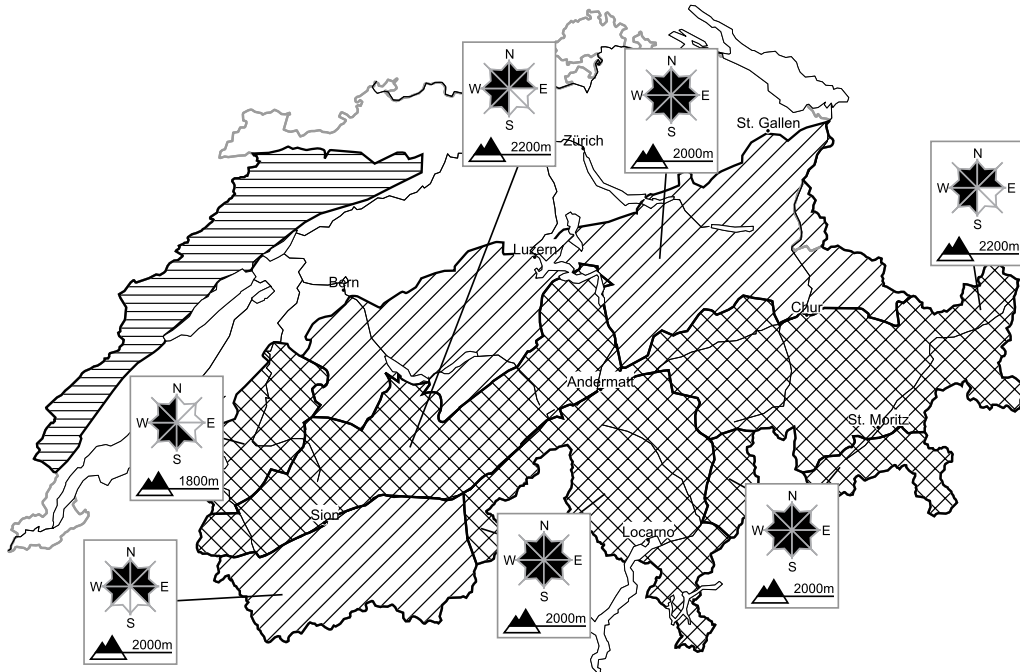

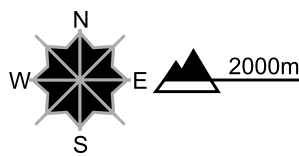
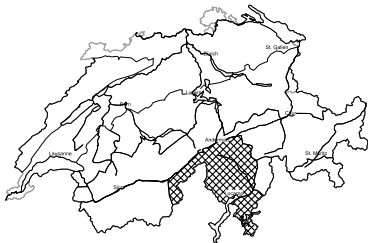

**Danger description**

The northerly wind has transported the loosely bonded old snow. Sometimes large snow drift accumulations have formed. These can be released by a single winter sport participant in some cases. In very isolated cases avalanches can also be triggered in the old snowpack and reach medium size. This applies in particular on steep, little used north facing slopes. These avalanche prone locations are rare but barely recognisable. Snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger.
