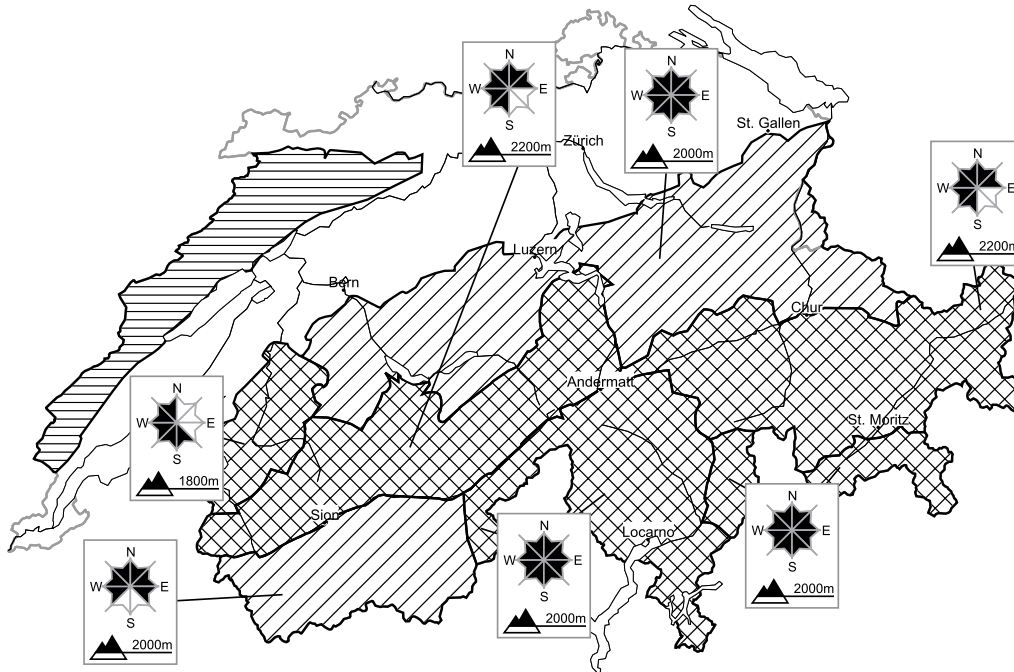


Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered in some regions. Snow drifts and weakly bonded old snow require caution

Avalanche danger



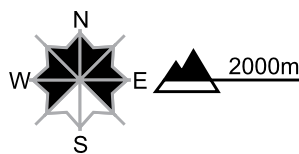
region F

Danger description

In particular in little used backcountry terrain avalanches can be triggered in the old snow. They can reach medium size in isolated cases. These avalanche prone locations are rare but barely recognisable. Defensive route selection is advisable.

As a consequence of the northeasterly wind clearly visible snow drift accumulations have formed. These are to be found in particular adjacent to the ridge line and in pass areas in all aspects. The prevalence of avalanche prone locations will increase with altitude. The snow drift accumulations are to be evaluated with care and prudence in steep terrain.
