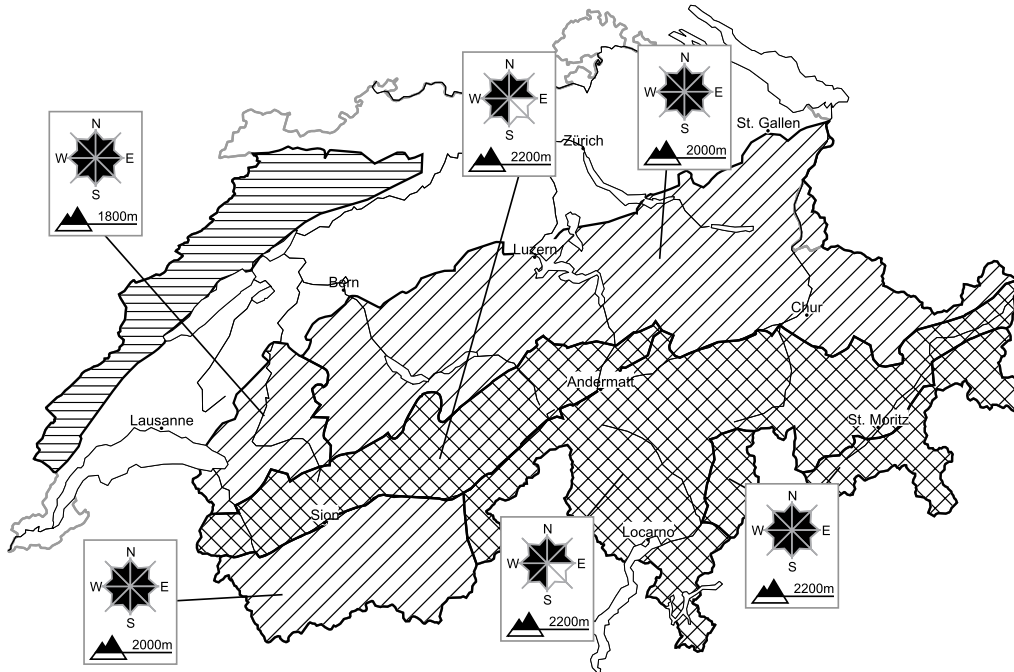


Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered in some regions

Danger description

As a consequence of the northerly wind clearly visible snow drift accumulations will form. These are to be found in particular adjacent to the ridge line and in pass areas. They are to be evaluated with care and prudence in steep terrain. In high Alpine regions avalanche prone locations are more widespread and the danger is level 3 (considerable). Avalanches can additionally be released in the weakly bonded old snow in very isolated cases. Caution is to be exercised in particular on steep, little used north facing slopes. These avalanche prone locations are rare but barely recognisable. Defensive route selection is advisable.
