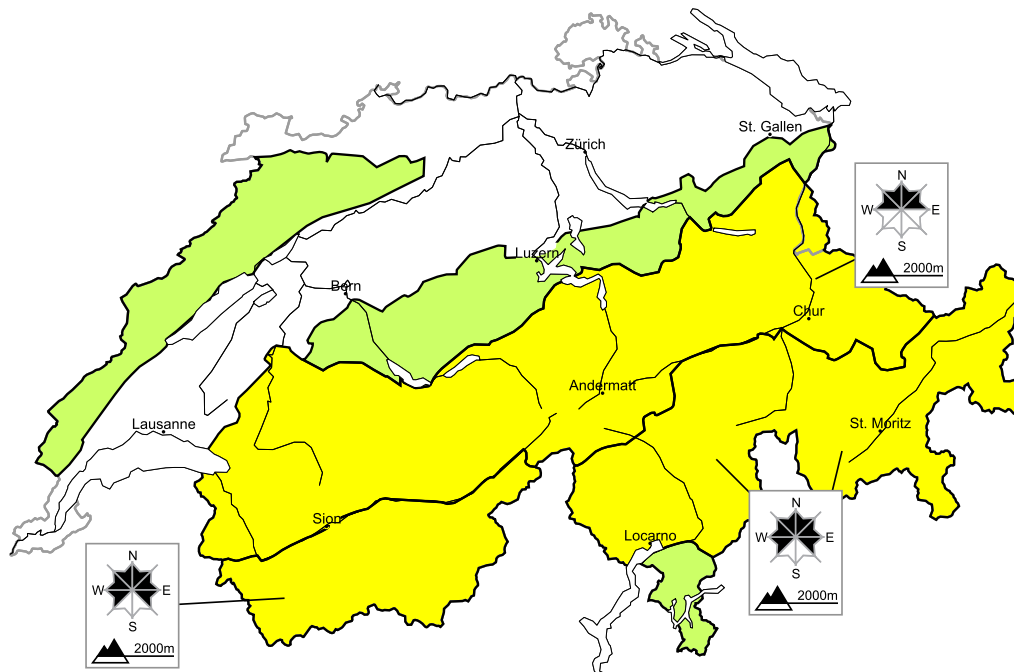


Moderate avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

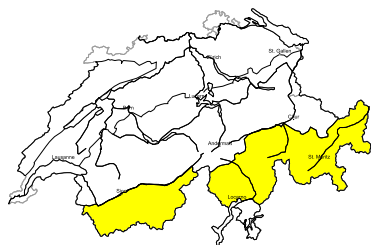

Avalanche danger



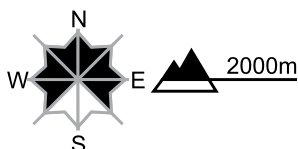
region A

Danger description

The snow drift accumulations of the last few days can be released, especially at their margins.

Avalanches can additionally in isolated cases be released in deeper layers. This applies in particular on very steep north facing slopes in little used backcountry terrain. Such avalanche prone locations are barely recognisable.

Careful route selection is important.

Full-depth avalanches

Below approximately 2400 m individual full-depth avalanches are possible, including large ones in isolated cases. Caution is to be exercised in areas with glide cracks.

Danger levels

1 low

2 moderate

3 consider.

4 high

5 very high
