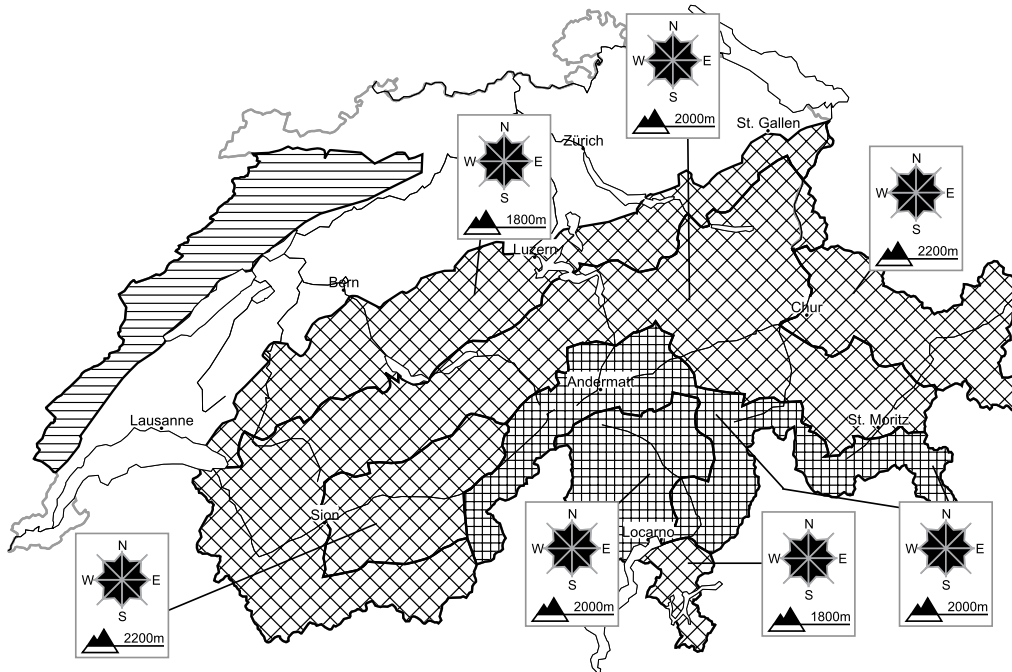


In the south a very critical avalanche situation will be encountered over a wide area

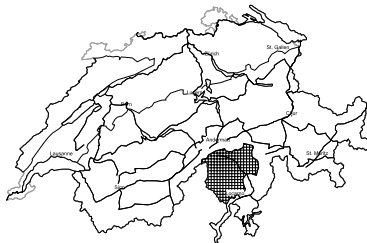

Avalanche danger



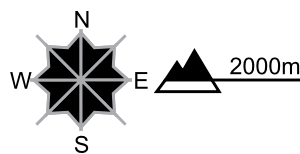
region A

Avalanche prone locations



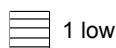
Danger description

During the course of the night numerous natural dry avalanches are to be expected, including large ones. They can release the weakly bonded old snow as well and can reach as far as areas without any snow cover. Exposed buildings and exposed parts of transportation routes are endangered in some cases. Temporary safety measures are to be reviewed. The conditions are unfavourable for snow sport activities outside marked and open pistes.

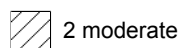
Wet and full-depth avalanches

At intermediate altitudes more frequent full-depth and wet avalanches are to be expected as a consequence of the rain. Slides are to be expected on cut slopes. Exposed parts of transportation routes can be endangered, this applies in particular during the night.

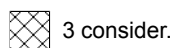
Danger levels



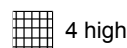
1 low
