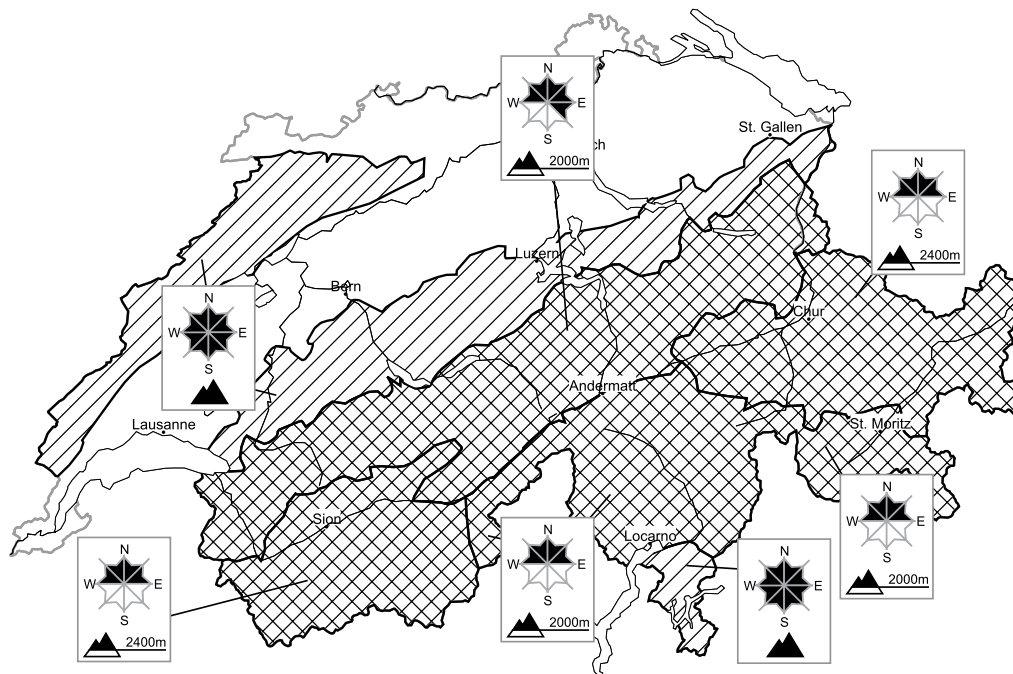

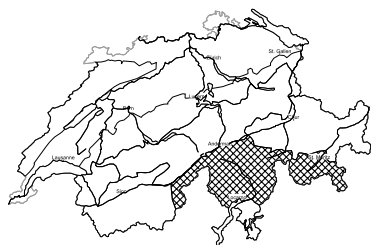

Avalanche danger



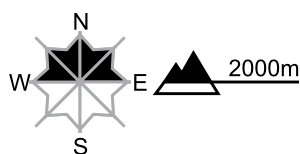
region A

Avalanche prone locations



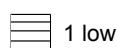
Danger description

The fresh snow and snow drift accumulations of the last few days are in some cases still prone to triggering. As a consequence of the strong wind further snow drift accumulations will form. Single snow sport participants can release avalanches. These can in isolated cases release deeper layers of the snowpack and reach quite a large size. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger.

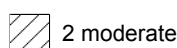
Wet and full-depth avalanches

As a consequence of the rain wet avalanches are possible below approximately 2000 m. Individual full-depth avalanches can also occur. This applies below approximately 2400 m.

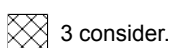
Danger levels



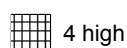

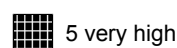
