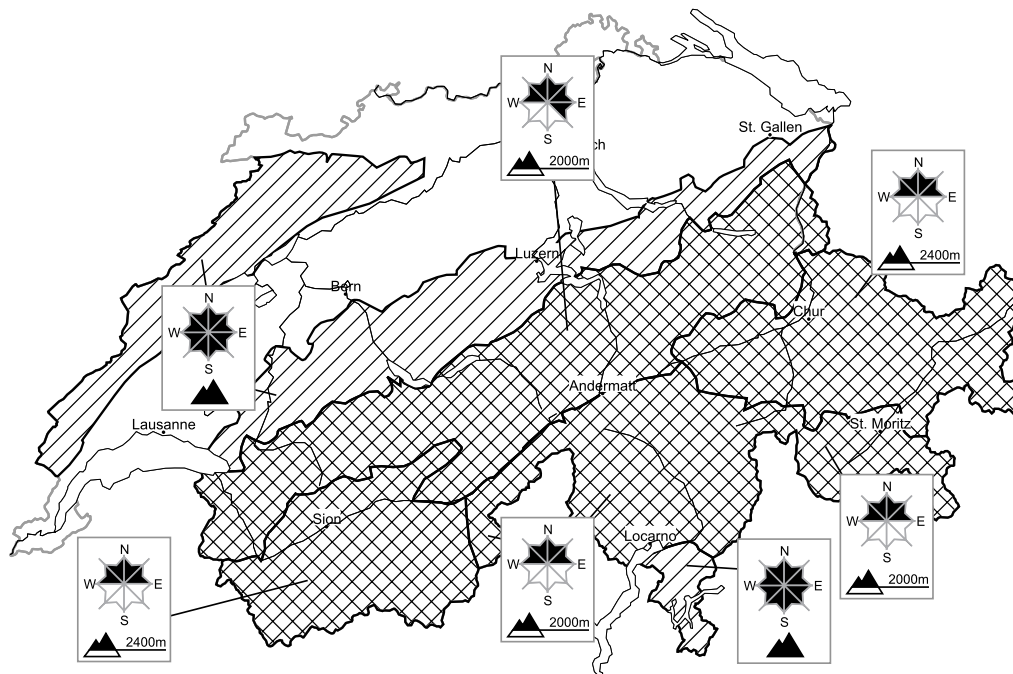


Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

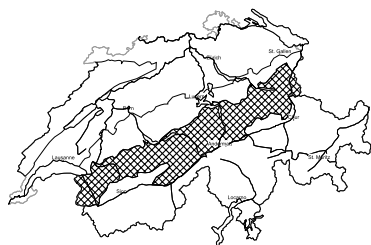

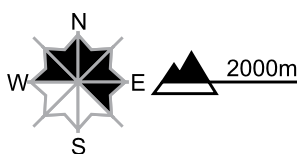

Danger description

The fresh snow and snow drift accumulations of the last few days are in some cases still prone to triggering. As a consequence of the strong wind further snow drift accumulations will form. Single snow sport participants can release avalanches. These can reach medium size in isolated cases. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger.

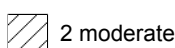
Wet avalanches as day progresses, Full-depth avalanches

On steep east, south and west facing slopes full-depth and wet avalanches are to be expected below approximately 2400 m. These can reach medium size. Backcountry tours should be concluded timely.

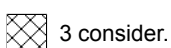
Danger levels



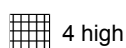

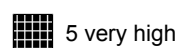
