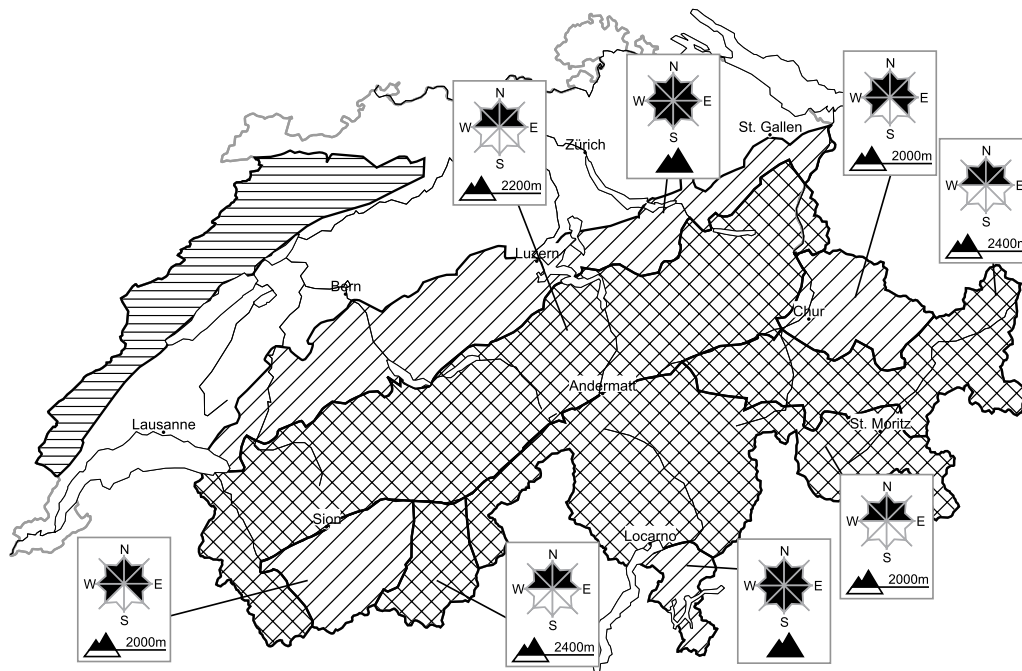


Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

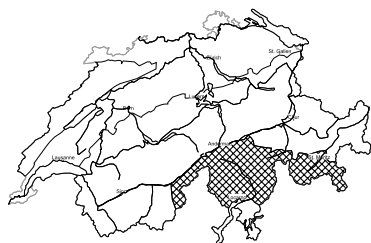

Avalanche danger



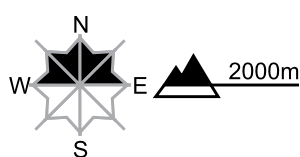
region A

Danger description

As a consequence of fresh snow and strong wind avalanche prone snow drift accumulations will form. Avalanches can additionally in isolated cases be released in deeper layers. This applies in particular on very steep north facing slopes in little used backcountry terrain. Avalanches can reach medium size. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger.

Wet and full-depth avalanches

At intermediate altitudes wet avalanches are possible as a consequence of the rain. Individual full-depth avalanches can also occur. This applies below approximately 2400 m.
